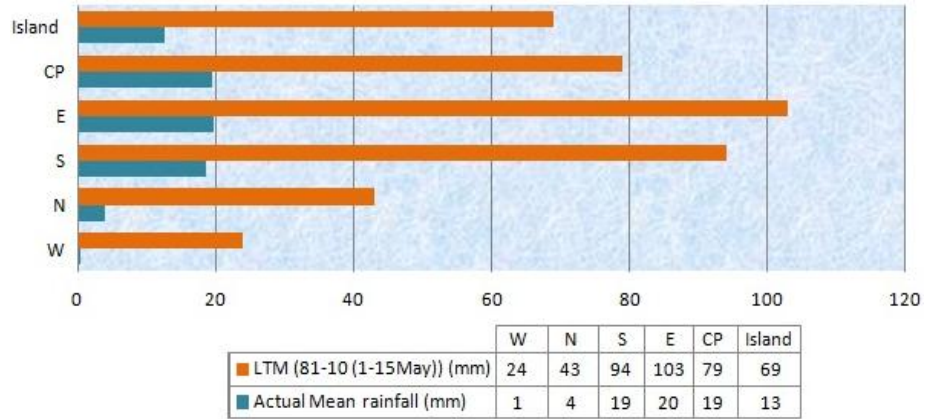

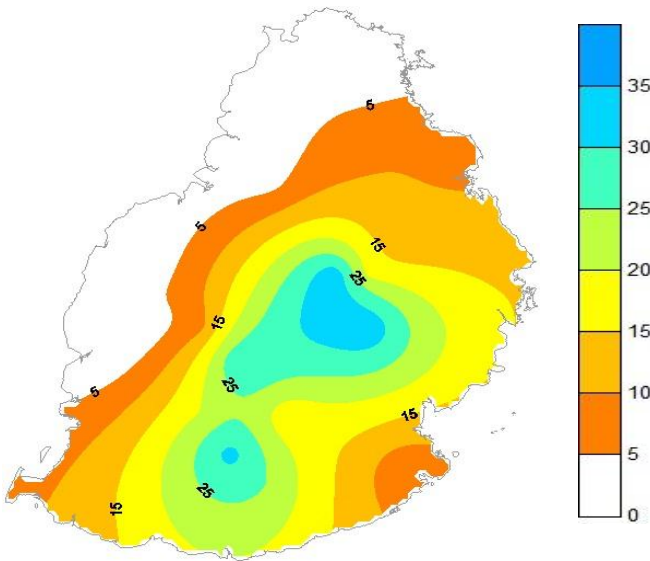
Mean Rainfall for 1-15 May 2018

Mauritius

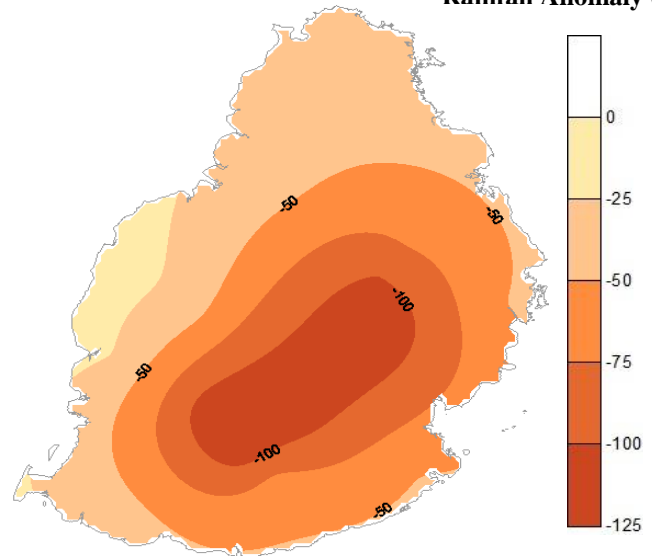
The first fortnight of May 2018 was dry with all regions over the island recording well below normal rainfall. Dry conditions were particularly felt over the Central Plateau and to the East with certain stations having deficient rainfall of over 100 mm.
