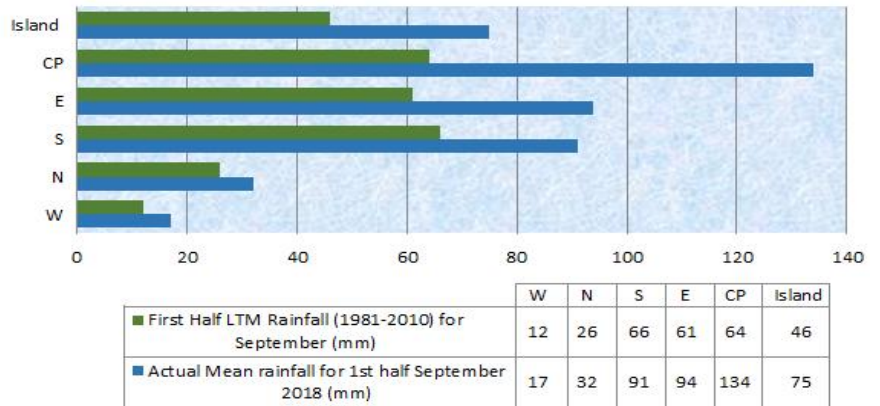


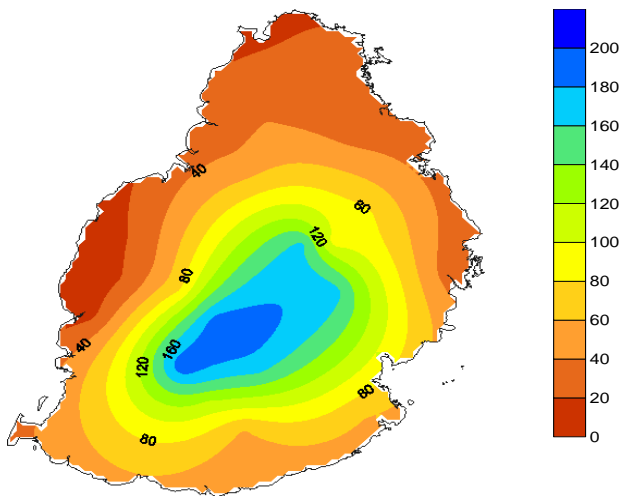
Mean Rainfall for 1-15 September 2018

Mauritius

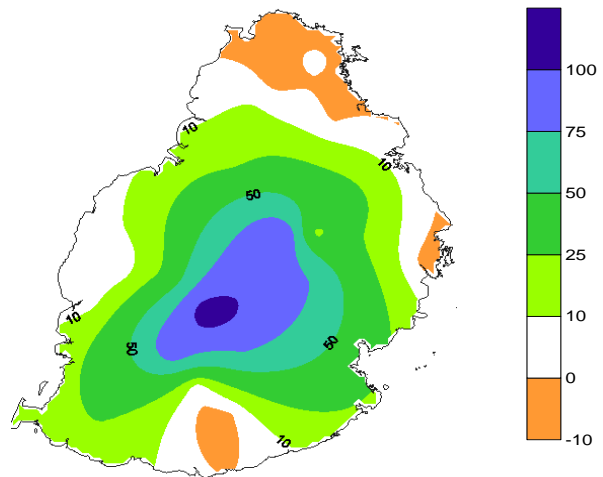
The first fortnight of September 2018 received an average of 75mm of rainfall over the island which represents 163 % of the long term mean for this period. All regions over the island received well above normal rainfall. Wet conditions were particularly felt over the Central Plateau with several stations recording over 75 mm of rain.

Normal rainfall was recorded over Rodrigues with about 94% of the fortnightly rainfall recorded.

Deficient rainfall was observed at Agalega and at St Brandon it was slightly below.
