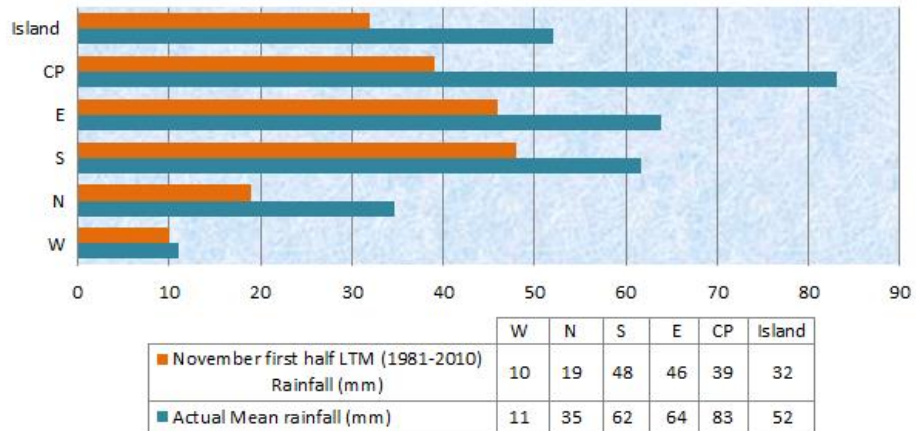


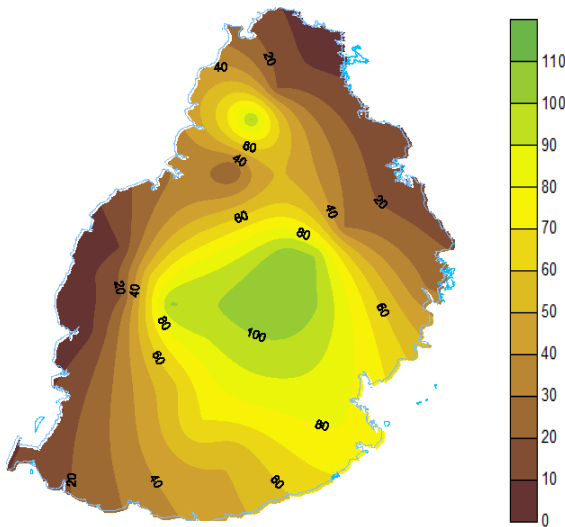
Mean Rainfall for 1-15 November 2018

Mauritius

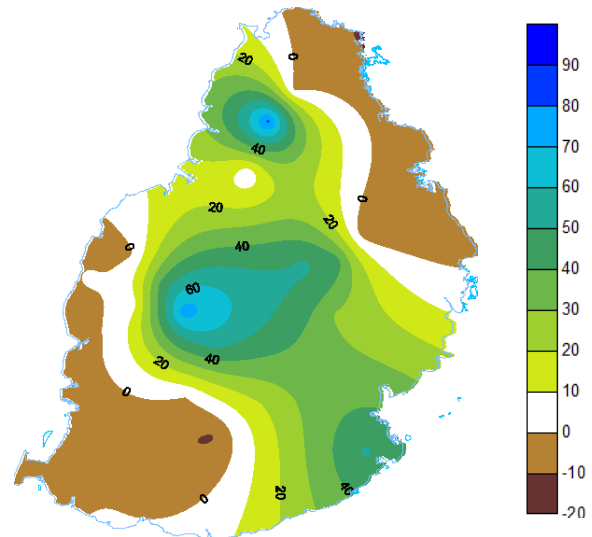
During the first fortnight 162% of the normal rainfall for the period was recorded, with an average of 52 mm, over the whole island. Almost all regions received normal to above normal reaching an excess of over 80 mm to the northwest. The south west rainfall was locally deficient by about 20 mm.

Dry conditions prevailed over Rodrigues during this first fortnight with about 30% of the normal rainfall for the period.

Very wet conditions prevailed over Agalega with over 400 % of its normal fortnight rainfall.

The first fortnight rainfall was below normal at St Brandon.
