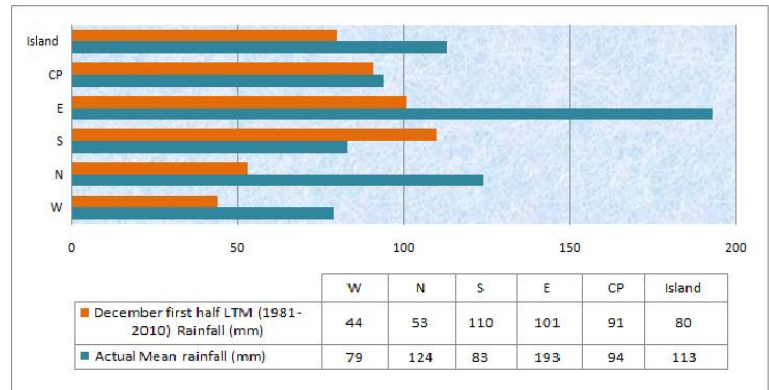


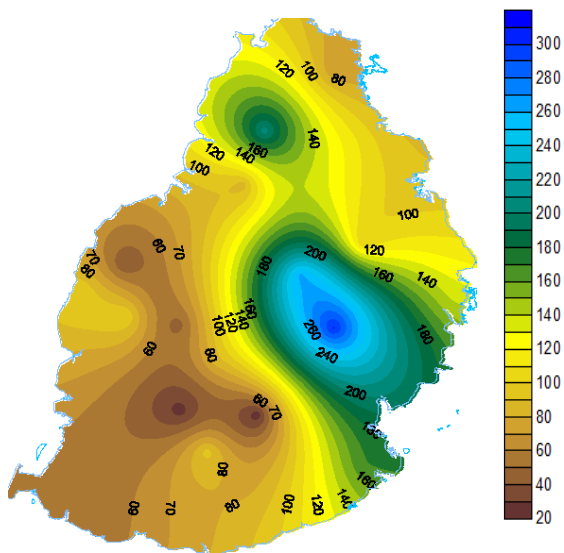
Mean Rainfall for 1-15 December 2018

Mauritius

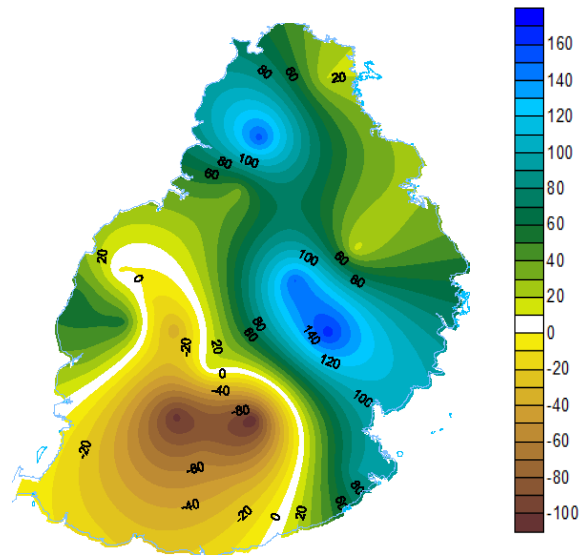
The first fortnight of December 2018 received above normal rainfall amounting to 113 mm, representing 141 % of the long term mean for the period. Excessive rainfall of over 150 mm was observed to the North and East. However, not all regions received above normal rainfall and over the Central Plateau it was deficient by 80-100 mm

Very wet conditions prevailed in some places in Rodrigues. Rainfall was in excess at Plaine Corail by 203 mm whereas at Citronelle it was deficient by 20 mm.

Above Normal rainfall was also observed at Agalega and St Brandon
