


Mean Rainfall for 1-30 April 2019

Mauritius

The month of April 2019 received above normal rainfall amounting to 335mm, representing 164 % of the long term mean. Rainfall was mainly associated with instability zones and afternoon local development. All regions received excessive rainfall except to the south. Excess rainfall up to 300mm was recorded over Central Plateau but deficit rainfall below 50mm was observed in the region of Britannia.
