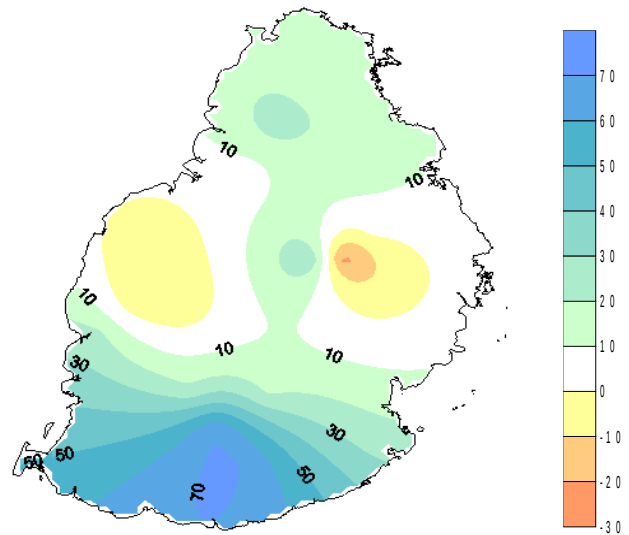
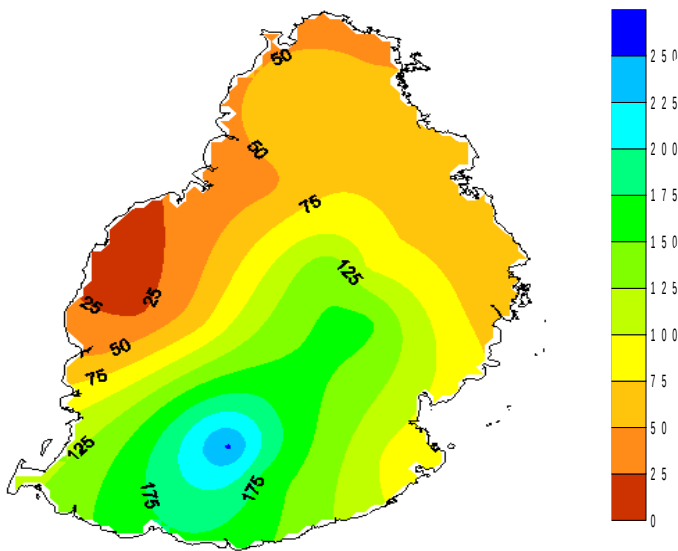
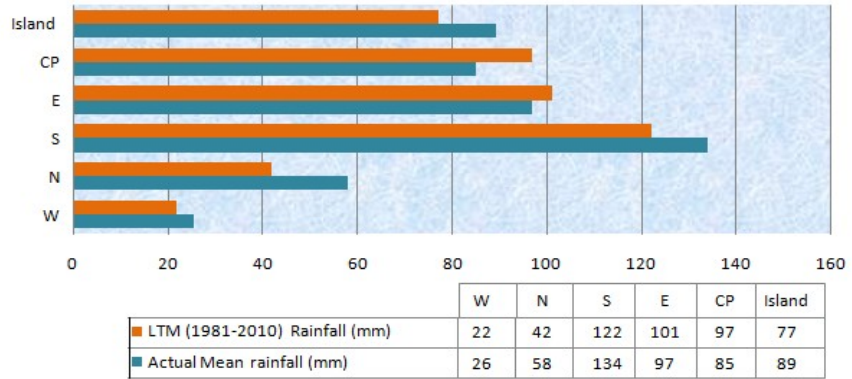


# Mauritius Meteorological Services

## Mean Rainfall for 01-31 October 2019

### Mauritius

October 2019 received slightly above normal rainfall amounting to 89mm, representing 116% of the long term mean for this month. Slightly deficient rainfall was observed to the East and West, while elsewhere it was normal to slightly wetter. Rainfall was locally deficient by 20mm in the region of Bel Etang while the regions of Bois Cheri and Britannia received about 60mm of rainfall in excess.
