


Mean Rainfall for 1-15 May 2020

Mauritius


The first half of May 2020 was very dry with well below normal rainfall amounting to 23 mm, representing 32 % of the long term mean for this period. Rainfall was mostly concentrated over the Central Plateau. The whole island received below normal rainfall. Rainfall was deficient locally by 100mm in the regions of Arnaud and Sans Souci.
