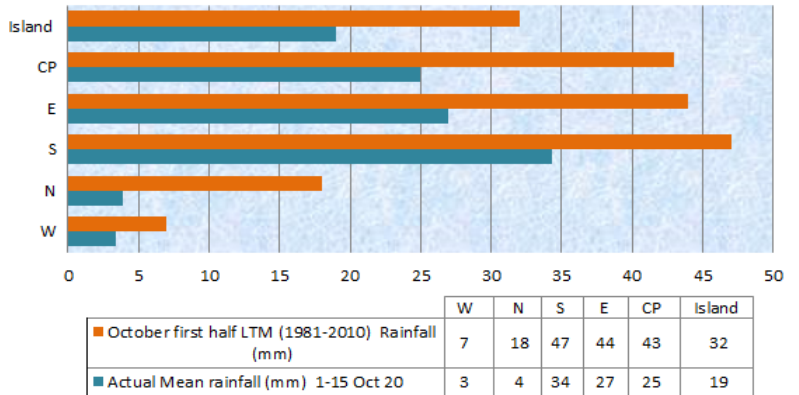

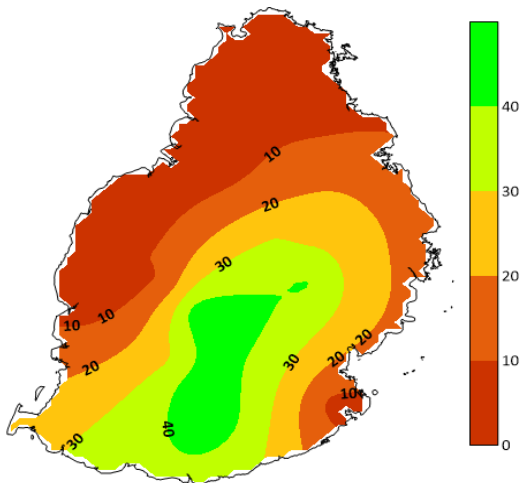
## Mean Rainfall for 1-15 October 2020

### Mauritius

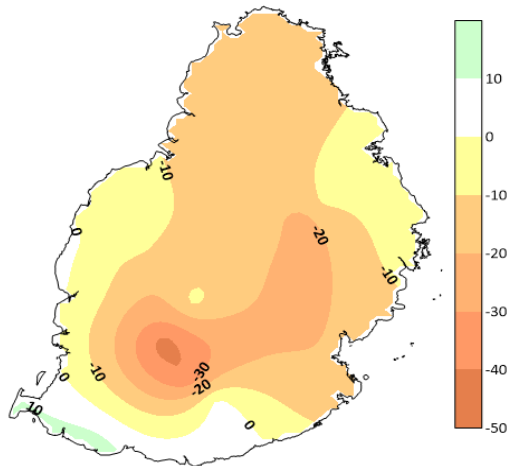
The first half of October 2020 had well below normal rainfall amounting to 19 mm, representing 59 % of the long term mean for this period. The whole island had below normal rainfall. Rainfall was locally deficient by about 40 mm in the region of Arnaud.
