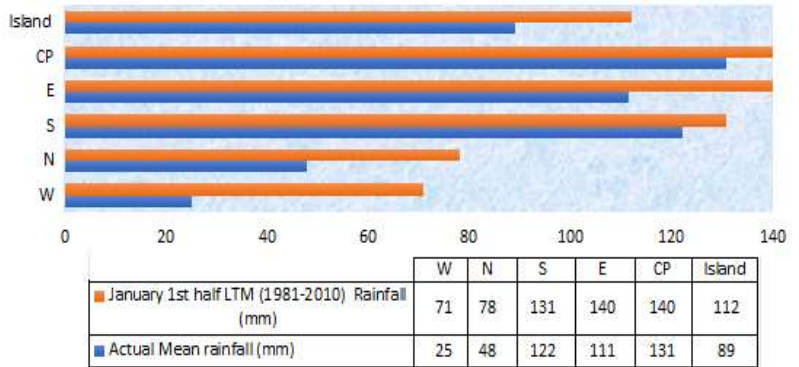

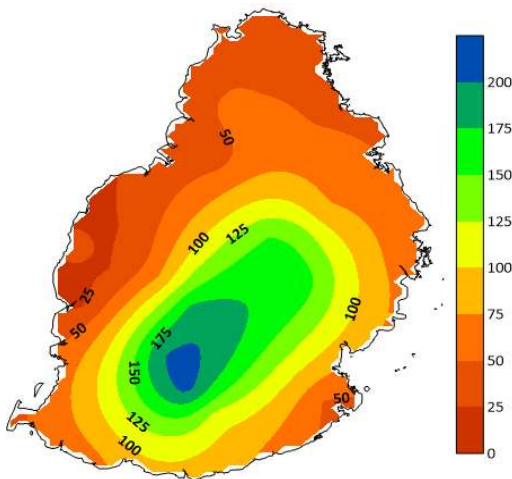
Mean Rainfall for 1-15 January 2021

Mauritius

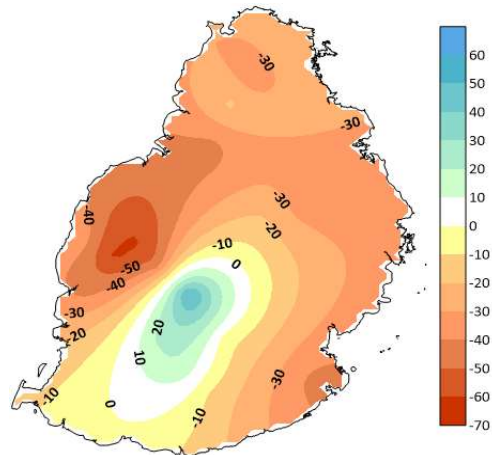
The first half of January 2021 had slightly below normal rainfall amounting to 89 mm, representing 80 % of the long term mean for this period. Close to normal rainfall was observed to the South and over the Central Plateau. It was exceptionally wet very locally in the region of Mon-Bois with an excess of 50mm of rain. Elsewhere rainfall was mainly well below normal. The region of Pierrefonds was locally deficient by 60 mm.
