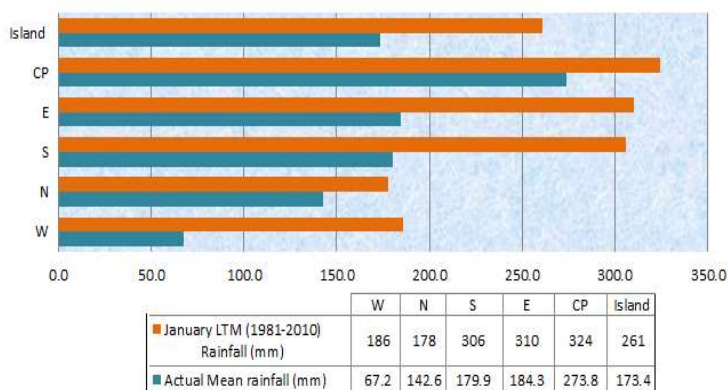


## Mauritius Meteorological Services

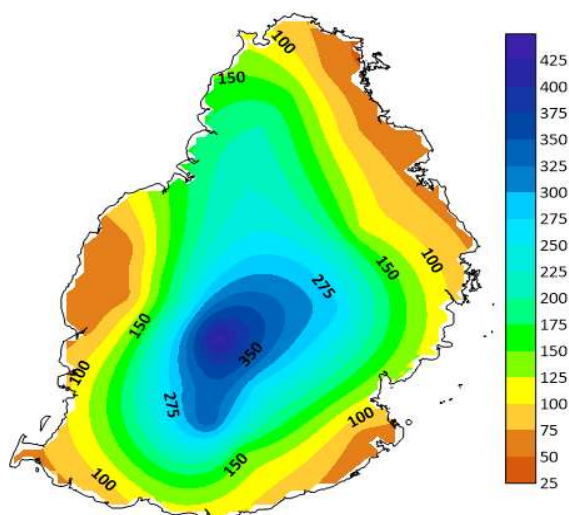
### Mean Rainfall for 1-31 January 2021

#### Mauritius

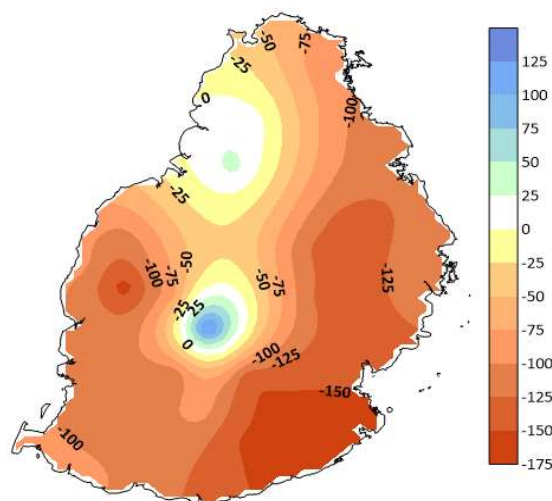
January 2021 had well below normal rainfall amounting to 173 mm, representing 66 % of the long term mean. Rainfall was slightly below normal to the North and over the Centre, well below normal to the East and the South. The West was dry. Rainfall was deficient by over 130 mm in the regions of FUEL, Sans-Souci, Plaisance, Britannia and Union Park; up-to 160mm deficient at Pierrefonds. On the other hand, an excess of about 140mm of rainfall was observed locally in the region of 16ème Mille Forest Side.
