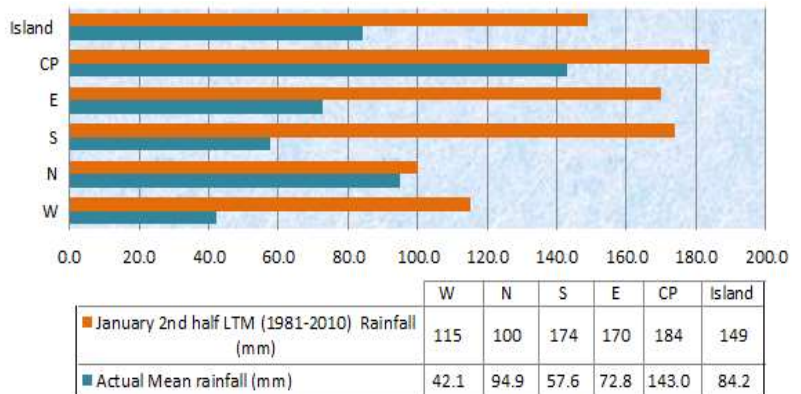


## Mauritius Meteorological Services

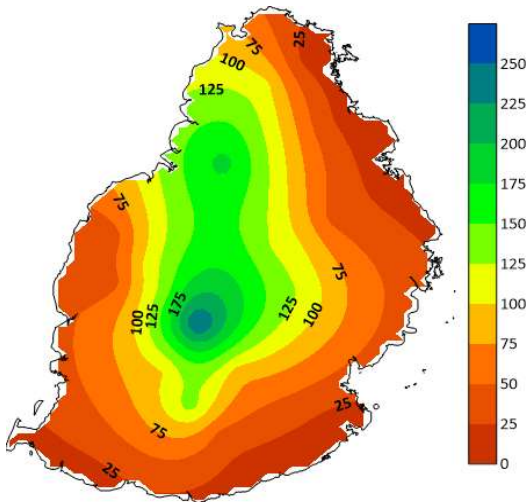
### Mean Rainfall for 16-31 January 2021

#### Mauritius

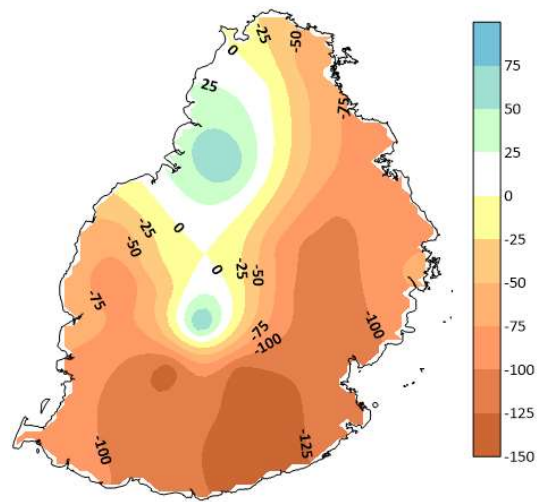
The second half of January 2021 had well below normal rainfall amounting to 84 mm, representing 56 % of the long term mean for this period. Rainfall was close to the normal in the North and below normal over the centre. Elsewhere, it was dry. Rainfall was locally deficient by 130 mm in the regions of Arnaud, Britannia and Union Park. However, it was very wet in the region of Valton and Mon-Bois with an excess of above 70mm of rainfall.
