


Mean Rainfall for 1-15 April 2021

Mauritius


The first half of April 2021 was wet with 150 mm of rain representing 145 % of the long term mean for this period. It was very wet to the Southeast and the South of the island. Excess rainfall of over 125mm was observed in the several localities to the southwest and the southeast. The region of Plaisance had excessive rainfall of over 250mm. In fact Plaisance recorded its monthly amount of rain in a single day, i.e on 15.
