


### Mean Rainfall for 1-15 May2021

# Mauritius


The first half of May had slightly below normal rainfall amounting to 60mm, representing 86 % of the long term mean. The southern sector had above normal rainfall whereas elsewhere rainfall was deficient; locally by 75 mm in the region of Sans Souci, while an excess rainfall of over 65mm was recorded at Britannia.
