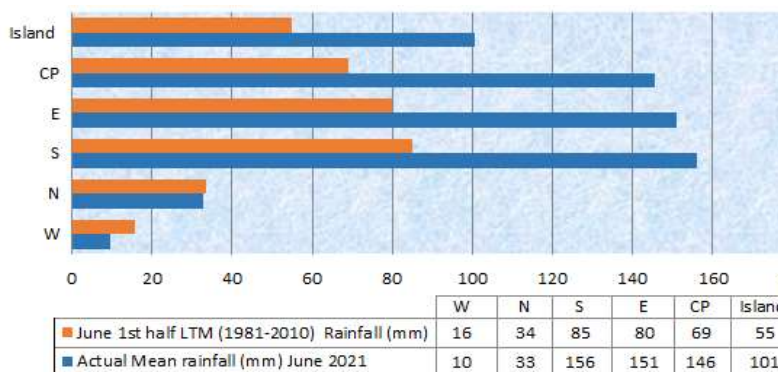


## Mauritius Meteorological Services

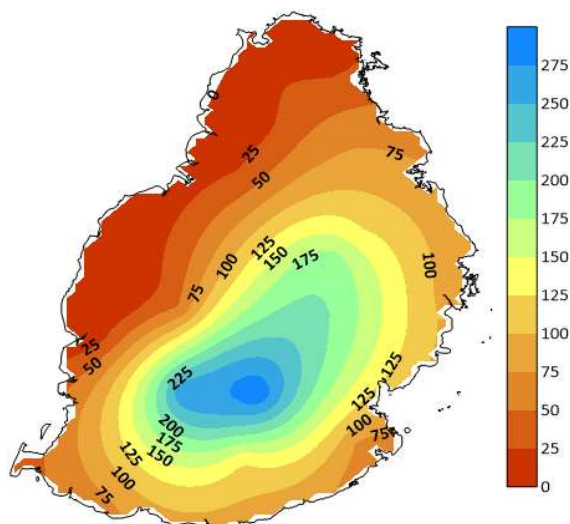
### Mean Rainfall for 1-15 June 2021

#### Mauritius

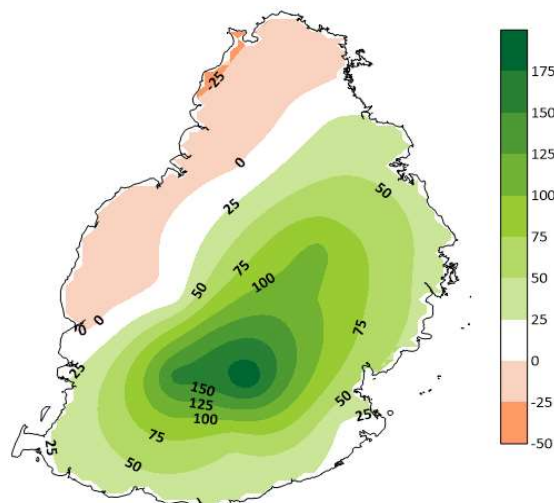
The first half of June 2021 was very wet with 101mm of rain, representing 184 % of the long-term mean. The East, South and the Central Plateau had well above normal rainfall. To the North rainfall was close to the normal but to the West it was deficient. Excess rainfall of over 150 mm was observed locally in the region of Arnaud and Union Park.
