


Mean Rainfall for 1-30 June 2021

Mauritius


June 2021 was very wet with 183 mm of rainfall amounting to 174 % of the long term mean. An excess of over 200 mm of rain was observed over the Central Plateau, whereas rainfall was slightly deficient to the West.
