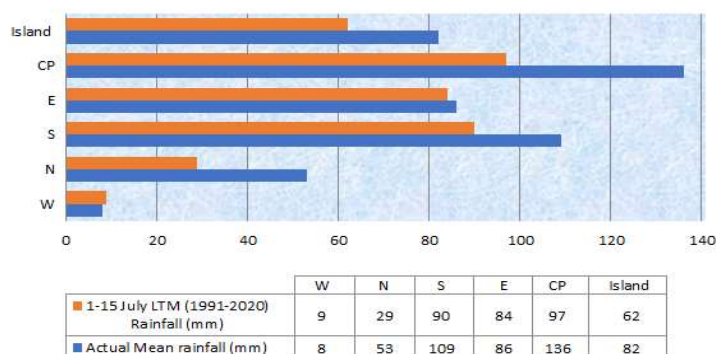

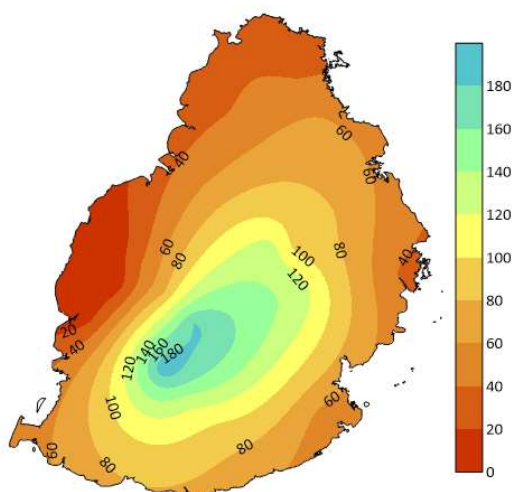
Mean Rainfall for 1-15 July 2021

Mauritius

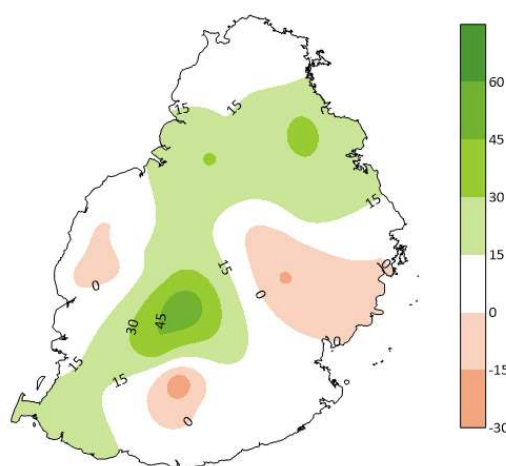
First fortnight of July 2021 had above normal rainfall amounting to 79mm, representing 128 % of the long-term mean. An excess of 44 and 60mm of rainfall was recorded at Mare-aux-Vacoas and Mon-Bois respectively. However, Bois-Cheri and Sans-Souci which are normally known as rainy regions were deficient in rainfall by 27 and 17mm respectively.
