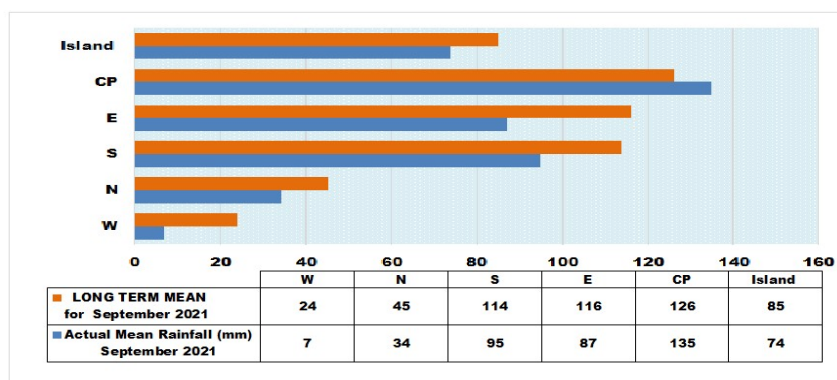

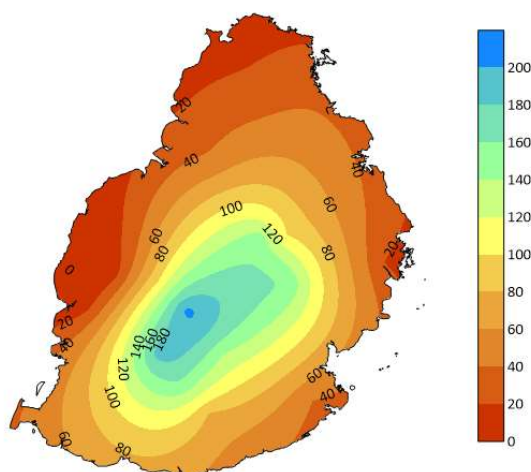
Mean Rainfall for 1-30 September 2021

Mauritius

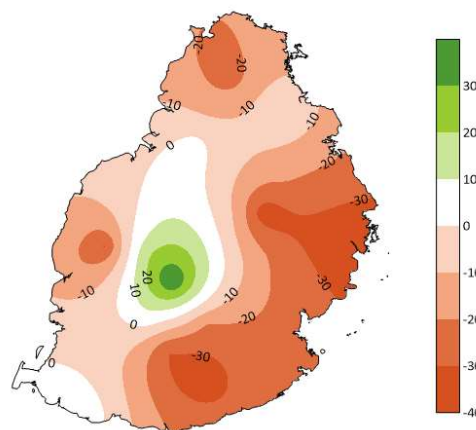
September 2021 had slightly below normal rainfall amounting to 74mm, representing 87% of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in excess over the high grounds by about 40mm at Mon Bois. However, in the other regions, it was deficient by about 25mm at Labourdonnais, 30mm at Pierrefonds, 35mm at Beau Champs and Britannia.
