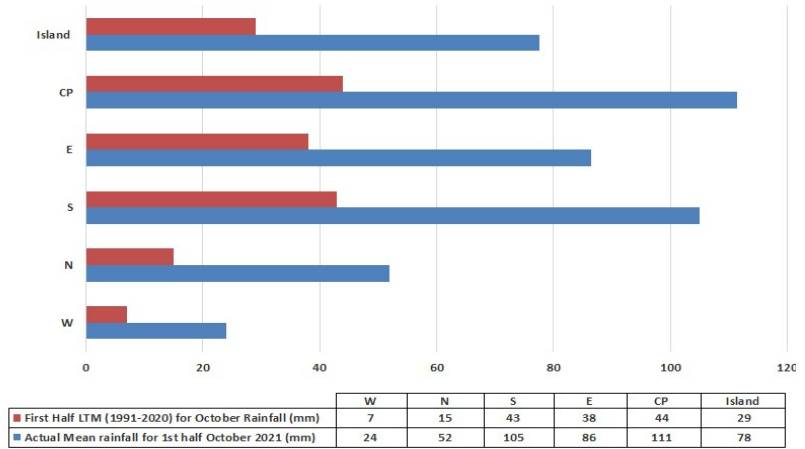

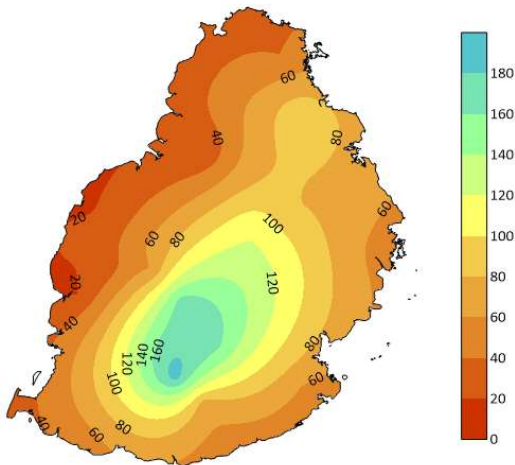
Mean Rainfall for 1-15 October 2021

Mauritius

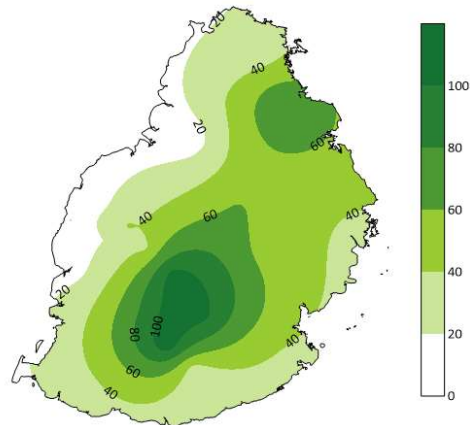
Very wet conditions prevailed over the island during the first fortnight of October 2021 with 76mm of rainfall, representing 262% of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in excess almost over the whole island and locally at Mon-Bois, Bois-Cheri and Union-Park, it was in excess by about 110mm.
