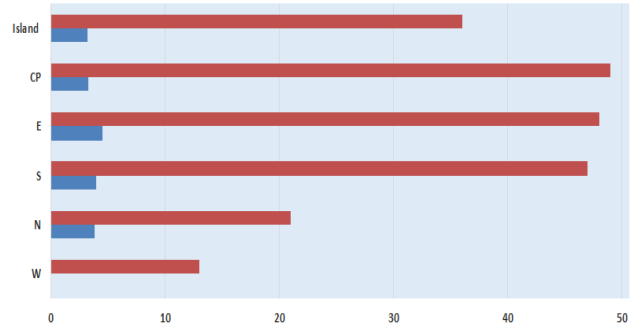


# Mauritius Meteorological Services

## Mean Rainfall for 1-15 November 2021

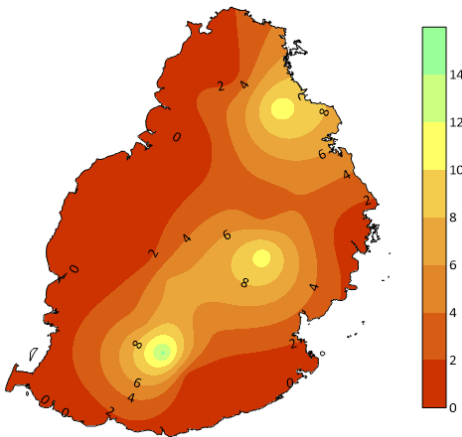
### Mauritius

Very dry conditions prevailed over the island during the first fortnight of November 2021 with 3 mm of rainfall, representing 8 % of the long-term mean. Rainfall was deficient almost over the whole island and locally at Sans Souci and Grand Providence, it was deficient by 60-66 mm.

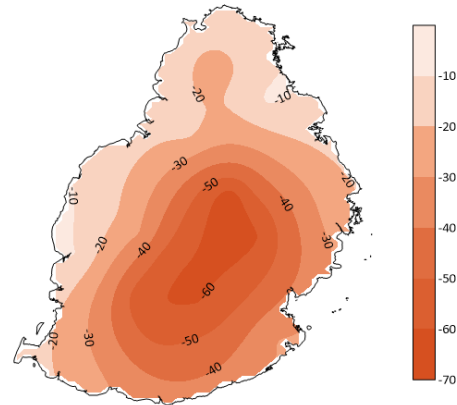
