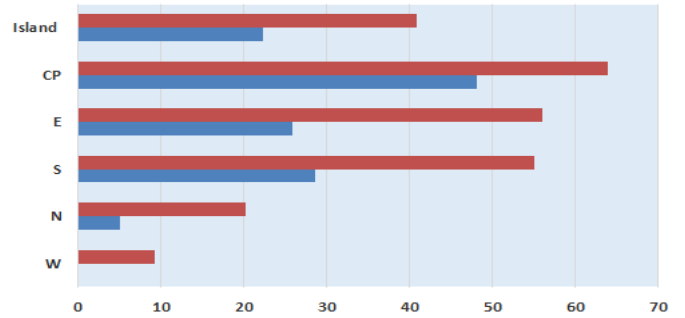


# Mauritius Meteorological Services

## Mean Rainfall for 1-15 September 2022

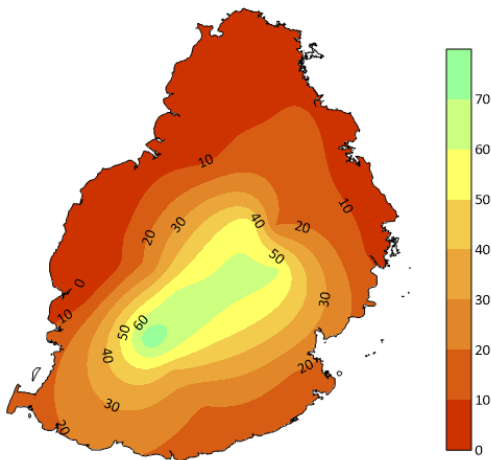
### Mauritius

The first fortnight of September 2022 recorded well below normal rainfall amounting to 22 mm, representing 54 % of the long-term mean. Rainfall was deficient almost over the whole island, especially in the region of Bois Cheri and Bel Etang, where the deficiency was by 45-55 mm.

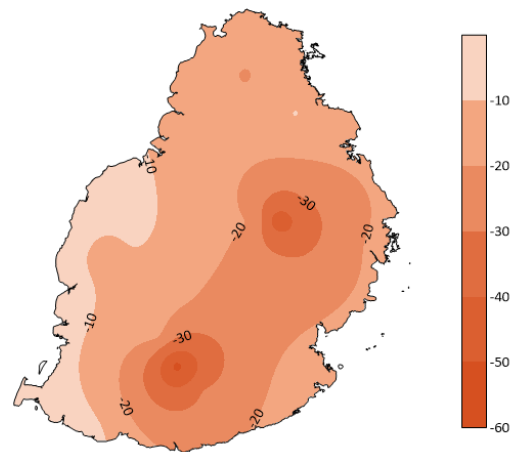
