THE MAURITIUS METEOROLOGICAL SERVICES ACT 2019

Regulations made by the Minister under sections 5, 6 and 11 of the Mauritius Meteorological Services Act 2019

1. These regulations may be cited as the Mauritius Meteorological Services (Charges) Regulations 2022.

2. In these regulations –

"Act" means the Mauritius Meteorological Services Act 2019.

3. (1) Any person who wishes to obtain any information or service specified in the Schedule shall apply to the Director in such manner as the Director may determine.

(2) The Director may, for the purpose of determining an application received under paragraph (1), make such enquiry as he considers appropriate.

(3) The Director may grant or refuse an application received under paragraph (1).

(4) Where the Director grants an application under paragraph (1), the applicant shall pay the appropriate charges specified in the Schedule at such time and in such manner as the Director may specify.

4. Notwithstanding regulation 3(4), the Director may supply, free of charge, any information or service to an applicant.

5. These regulations shall come into operation on 17 September 2022.
