


#### Mean Rainfall for 1-15 November 2022

### **Mauritius**


Below normal rainfall was recorded during the first fortnight of November 2022, amounting to 26 mm, representing 72 % of the long-term mean. Rainfall was deficient almost over the whole island, especially in the region of Arnaud, Sans Souci, Grand Providence and Bois Cheri, where the deficiency was by 35-45 mm. However, in the region of Mon Loisir, Tamarin Estate and Medine, rainfall was locally in excess by 15-35 mm.
