

# Mean Rainfall for 16-28 February 2023


## **Mauritius**

Dry conditions prevailed over the island for the second fortnight of February 2023. Mauritius recorded 63 mm of rainfall which represents 41% of the long-term mean. Rainfall was deficient almost over the whole island, especially in the region of Bel Etang, Grande Providence, Mon Bois and Sans Souci where it was by 135-210 mm. However, locally at Tamarin, rainfall was in excess by about 10 mm.


