


# Mean Rainfall for 1-15 March 2023

# **Mauritius**


Well above normal rainfall was recorded during the first fortnight of March 2023, amounting to 224 mm, representing 145 % of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in excess almost over the whole island especially in the region of Arnaud, Ferret and Grande Providence, where it was by 100-165 mm.
