

Mean Rainfall for 16-31 August 2023


Mauritius

Well below normal rainfall was recorded during the second fortnight of August 2023 amounting to 36 mm of rainfall, which represents 69 % of the long-term mean. Rainfall was deficient in almost all regions, especially at Sans Souci, Bel Etang and Grand Providence, where it was by 45-65 mm. However, locally at Bel Ombre, rainfall was in excess by around 10 mm.


