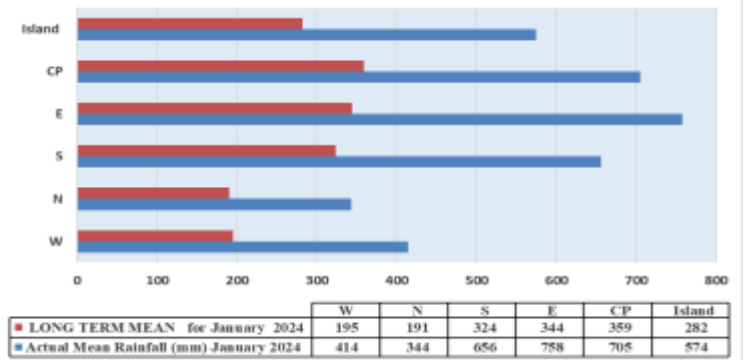

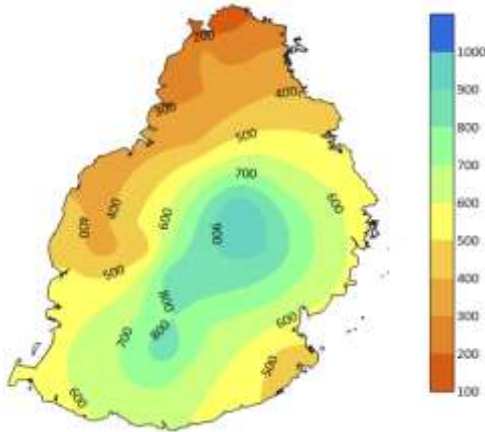
## Mean Rainfall for 1-31 January 2024

### Mauritius

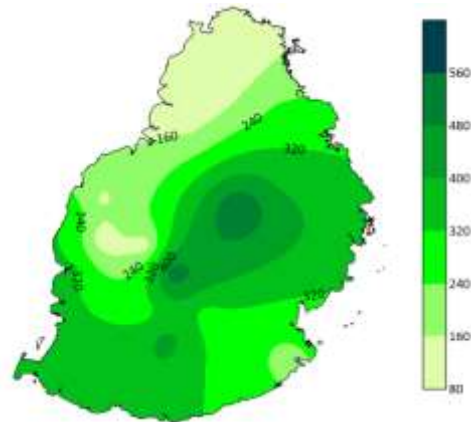
January 2024 turned out to be the ninth wettest January on record since 1904 and fourth wettest January since the last 30 years, amounting to 574 mm which represents 204 % of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in excess in almost all regions, especially at Bel Etang, Mon Bois and Grande Providence, where it was by 475-560 mm.
