



## Mean Rainfall for 1-30 June 2024 updated on 11 July 2024

### **Mauritius**

Above normal rainfall was recorded for June 2024, amounting to 152 mm which represents 130 % of the long-term mean.

The highest mean rainfall for the month was observed over the Central Plateau of Mauritius


- Well below normal rainfall was recorded over Rodrigues
- Very wet conditions were observed over Agalega



# Temperature June 2024


Minimum temperatures were on average 1.1 °C and 1.5 °C higher than the normal at Vacoas and Plaisance respectively.


Maximum temperatures were on average  $-0.5~^{\circ}\text{C}$  lower than the normal at Vacoas and  $0.2~^{\circ}\text{C}$  warmer than the normal at Plaisance.



## Rainfall and Temperature Forecast for Jul-Aug-Sep (JAS) 2024

Neutral ENSO, IOD and SIOD conditions are expected to prevail during the forecast period.

Sea surface temperatures are expected to be above normal and pressure anomalies to be near normal in the Mascarene region as shown in the SST and pressure anomaly charts respectively.

#### **Consensus forecast for Mauritius**

Cumulative rainfall for July to September 2024 is expected to be near normal. The monthly rainfall forecasted, based on statistical analysis and models is as follows:

• July: Normal (about 110 mm)

• August: Normal (about 100 mm)

• September: Normal (about 90 mm)

Mean temperature is forecasted to be above normal over the whole island.


