

Mean Rainfall for 01-15 August 2024 updated on 21 August 2024

Mauritius

The first fortnight of August 2024 was dry with 18 mm of rainfall which represents 33 % of the long-term mean.

The Western region recorded the least rainfall amount and the lowest percentage.
