Mean Rainfall for 01-15 April 2025 updated 17 April 2025


Mauritius

Near normal was recorded over Mauritius for the first fortnight of April 2025, amounting to 109 mm, which represents 98 % of the long-term mean.

The Central Plateau recorded the highest rainfall of 146 mm and the North observed the highest percentage of 175 % of the long-term mean.
