

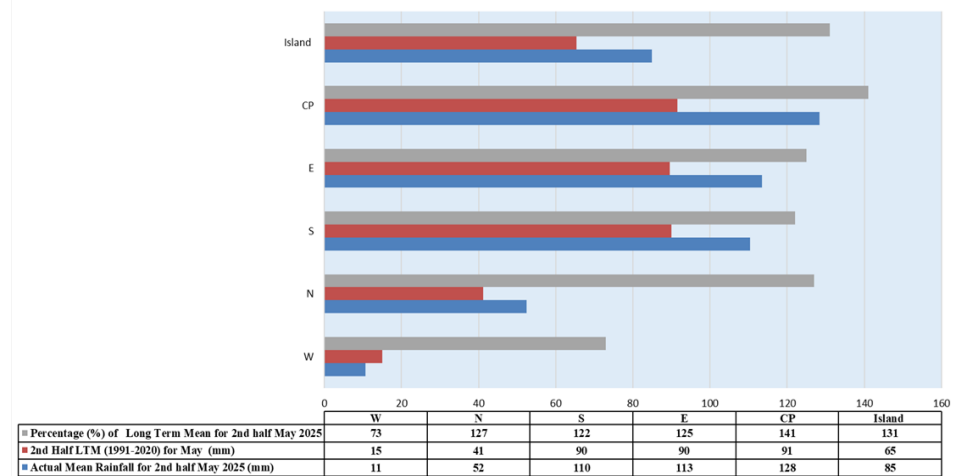

Mean Rainfall for 16-31 May 2025 updated on 5 June 2025

Mauritius

Well above normal rainfall was recorded in the second fortnight of May 2025, amounting to 85 mm which represents 131 % of the long-term mean.

The Central Plateau recorded the highest rainfall and percentage, amounting to 128 mm and 141% respectively.
