Mean Rainfall for 1-15 August 2025 updated 19 August 2025


Mauritius

Slightly below normal rainfall was recorded for the first fortnight of August 2025, amounting to 49 mm which represents 89 % of the long-term mean.

The South recorded the highest rainfall, amounting to 73 mm whereas in the West rainfall observed was nil.
