Mean Rainfall for 1-15 October 2025 updated 17 October 2025


Mauritius

Slightly below normal rainfall was recorded for the first fortnight of October 2025, amounting to 24 mm which represents 83 % of the long-term mean.

The Central Plateau recorded the highest rainfall amounting to 42 mm whereas in the West rainfall observed was nil.
