

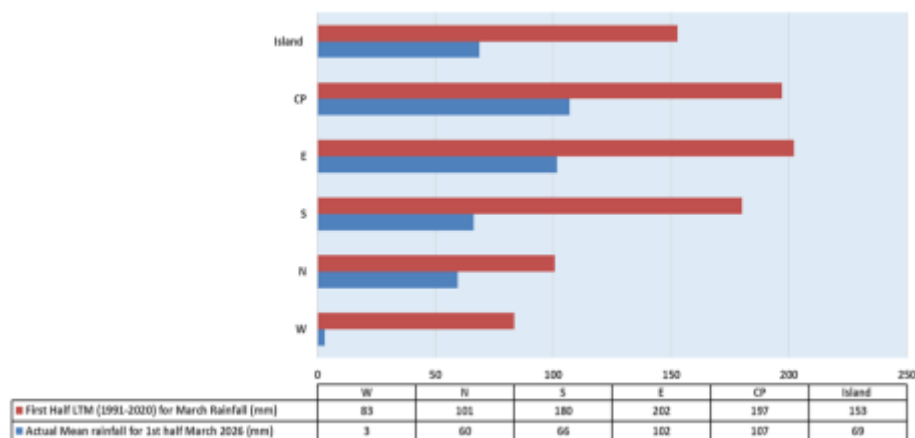

Mean Rainfall for 1-15 March 2026 updated 17 March 2026

Mauritius

Dry atmospheric conditions prevailed over the island for the first fortnight of March 2026. The rainfall recorded amounted to 69 mm, representing 45 % of the long-term mean.

The West recorded the lowest rainfall amount of 3 mm and the lowest percentage of 4% of the long term mean..
