

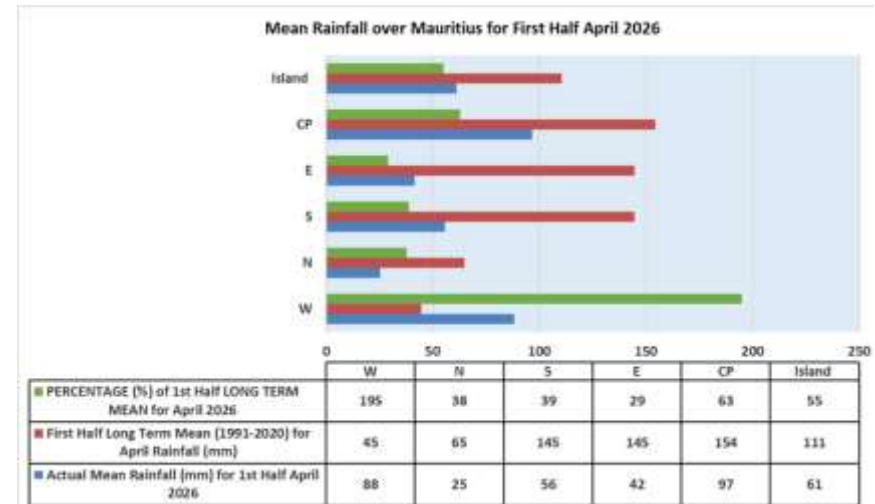

Mean Rainfall for 1-15 April 2026 updated on 20 April 2026

Mauritius

Well below rainfall was recorded for the first fortnight of April 2026, amounting to 61 mm, representing 55 % of the long-term mean.

The Central Plateau received the highest rainfall amount of 97 mm whereas the West recorded the highest percentage of 195 % of the long-term mean.
