

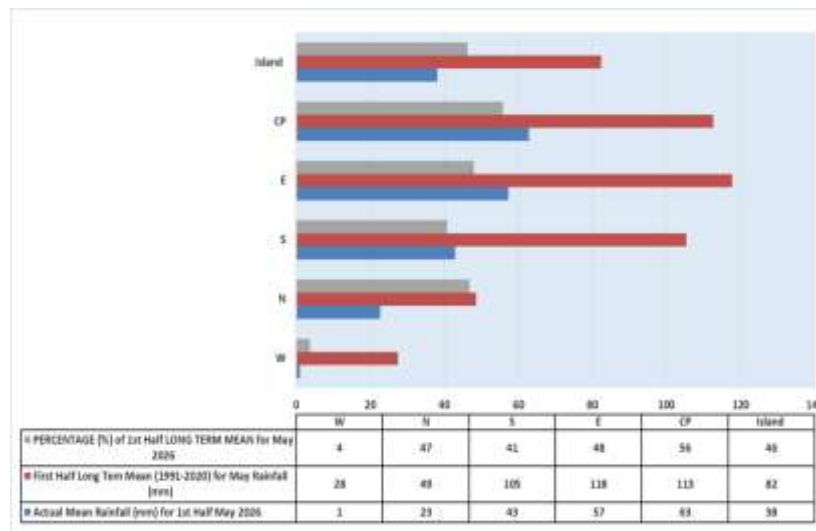
## Mauritius Meteorological Services

### Mean Rainfall for 1-15 May 2026 updated 19 May 2026

#### Mauritius

Dry atmospheric conditions prevailed over the island during the first fortnight of May 2026 and it was ranked as the fourth driest first fortnight for May since the last 20 years. The rainfall recorded amounted to 38 mm, representing 46 % of the long-term mean.

The West recorded the lowest rainfall amount of 1 mm and the lowest percentage of 4% of the long-term mean.
