

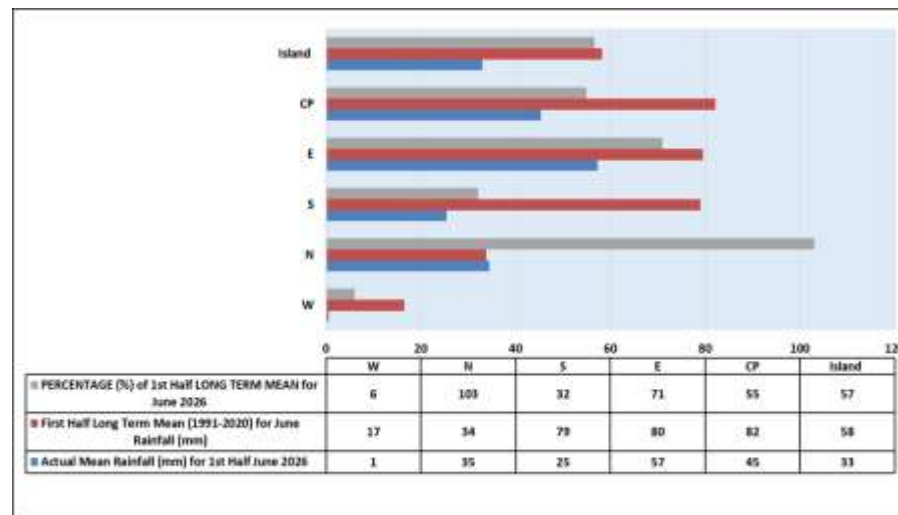
Mauritius Meteorological Services

Mean Rainfall for 1-15 June 2026 updated 18 June 2026

Mauritius

Well below normal rainfall was recorded for the first fortnight of June 2026 and it was ranked as the fourth driest first fortnight for June since the last 20 years. The rainfall recorded amounted to 33 mm, representing 57 % of the long-term mean.

The West recorded the lowest rainfall amount of 1 mm and the lowest percentage of 6% of the long-term mean.
