

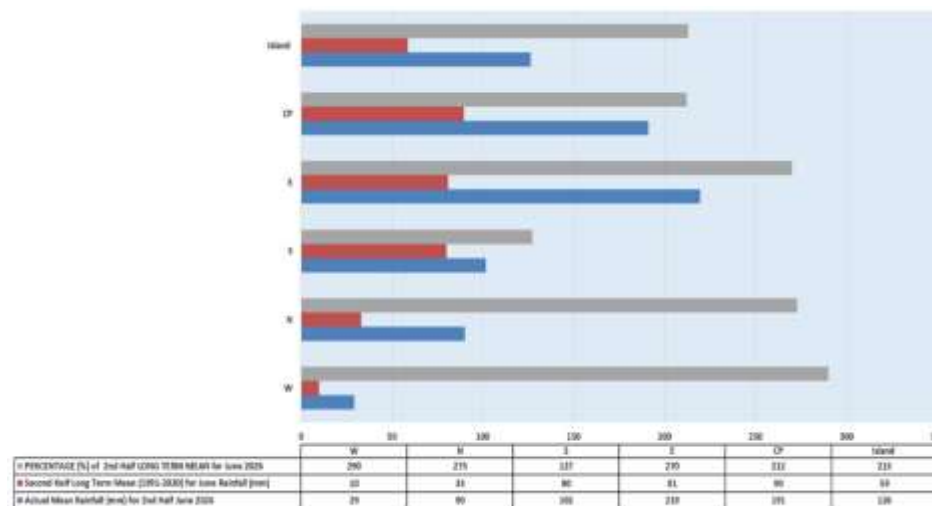

Mean Rainfall for 16-30 June 2026 updated on 7 July 2026

Mauritius

Very wet atmospheric conditions prevailed during second fortnight of June 2026. Rainfall recorded amounted to 126 mm and representing 213 % of the long-term mean.

The East recorded the highest rainfall of 219 mm whereas North had the highest percentage of 290% of the long-term mean. The rainfall recorded from 25 to 26 June accounted for approximately 46% of the mean rainfall for the second fortnight of June 2026.
