

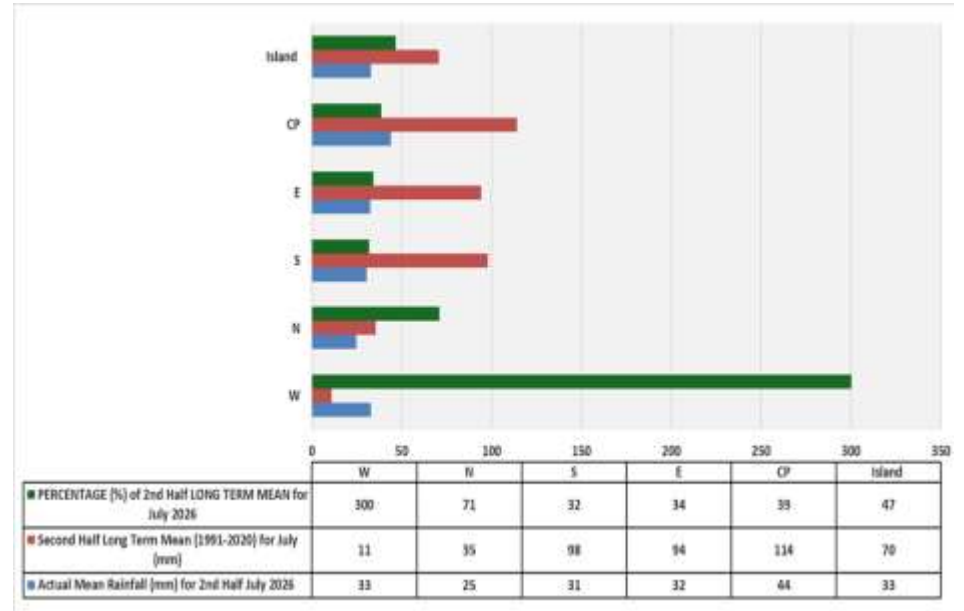

Mean Rainfall for 16-31 July 2026 updated on 6 August 2026

Mauritius

Dry atmospheric conditions prevailed over Mauritius during the second fortnight of July 2026. Rainfall recorded amounted to 33 mm and representing 47 % of the long-term mean.

Clouds associated with an instability line crossed the western half on the 17, accounting for 300% of the long-term mean for the second fortnight of July 2026.
