

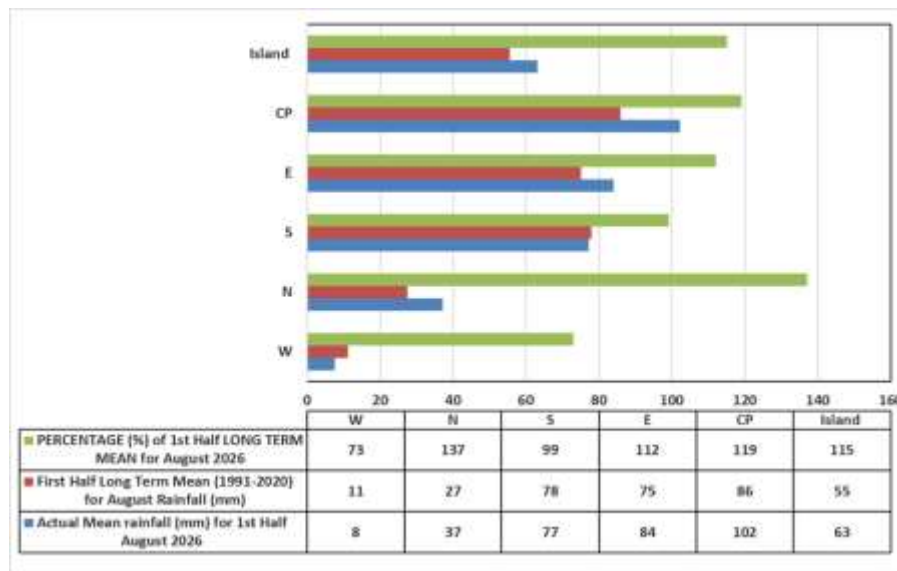

Mean Rainfall for 1-15 August 2026 updated 18 August 2026

Mauritius

Slightly above normal rainfall was recorded over Mauritius for the first fortnight of August 2026, amounting to 63 mm, representing 115 % of the long-term mean.

The Central Plateau recorded the highest rainfall amount of 102 mm whereas the highest percentage of 137% of the long-term mean was recorded in the North
