



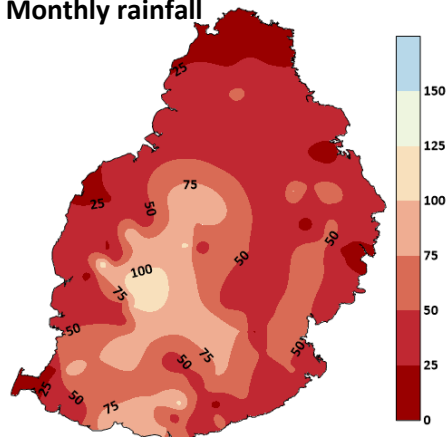

CLIMATE JULY 2026

Introduction

July 2026 was dry, while the mean temperature was above normal. The El Niño–Southern Oscillation (ENSO) strengthened to a moderate El Niño state by mid-July. The Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD) remained neutral, whereas the Subtropical Indian Ocean Dipole (SIOD) was in a positive phase. The Madden–Julian Oscillation (MJO) signal remained generally weak over the Indian Ocean.

Monthly rainfall



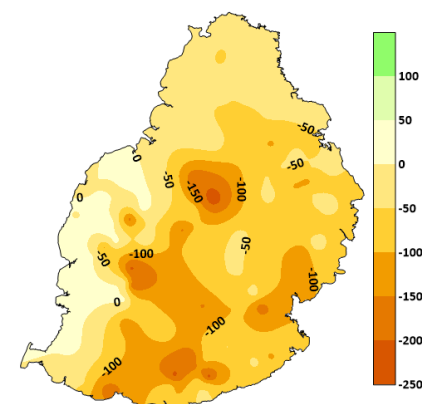
Rainfall

July 2026 was dry with 58 mm of rainfall, representing 44% of the long-term mean.

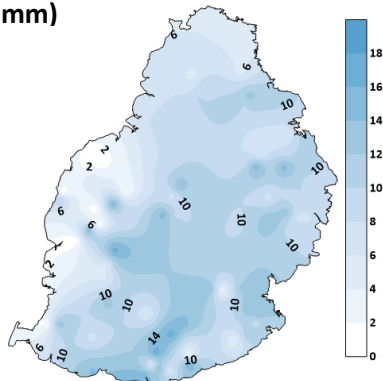
The Central Plateau recorded the highest rainfall, amounting to 211mm, whereas the West observed the highest percentage of 170 % of the long-term mean.

The highest cumulative rainfall for the month was 146.5 mm, recorded at Petrin.

Monthly rainfall Anomaly



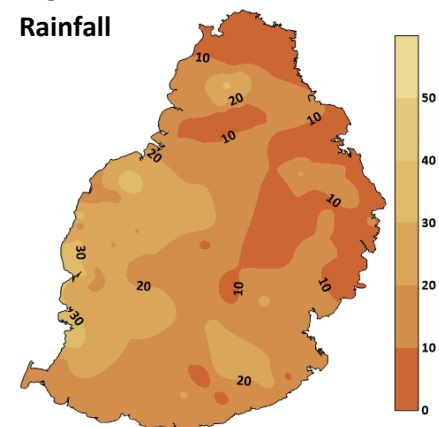
Rainfall days
(> 1 mm)



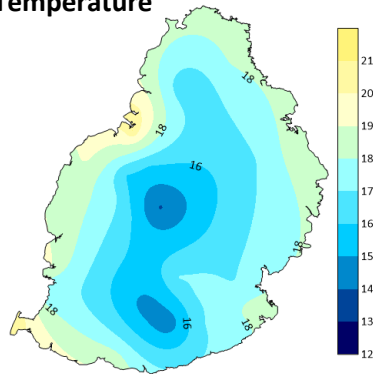
The highest number of rainy days (≥ 1 mm) was observed at Petrin with 18 rainy days.

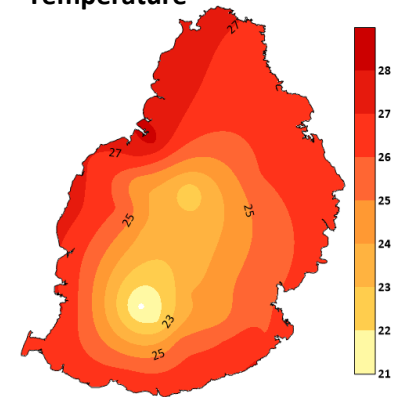

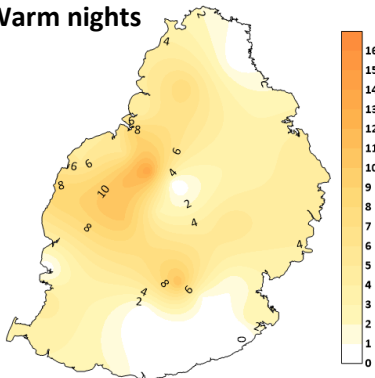
The highest maximum temperature recorded during the month was 31.6°C at Champ de Mars on 13 July. The lowest maximum temperature was 16.0°C, observed at Grand Bassin on 08 July.

The highest minimum temperature for the month was 24.0°C, recorded at Line Barracks, Port-Louis on 11 July. The lowest minimum temperature was 11.0°C, registered at Mon Desert Alma on 24 July.

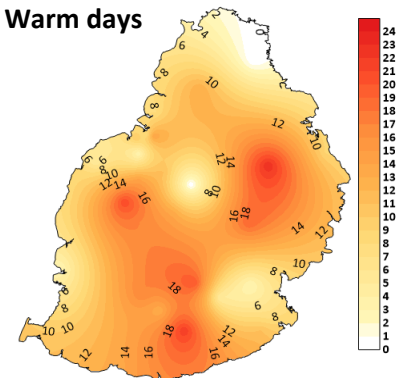
Warm nights



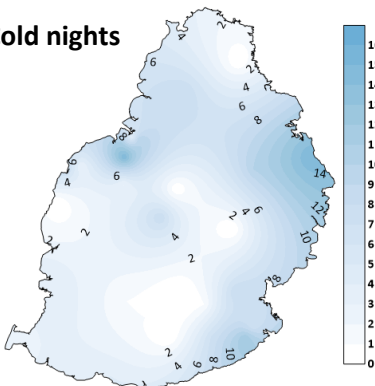
The highest number of warm nights observed was 14 at Mon Desert Alma.

Warm days



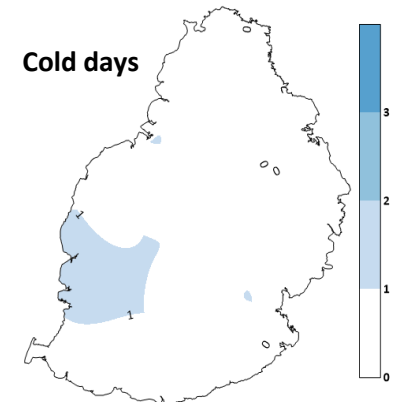
Cold nights



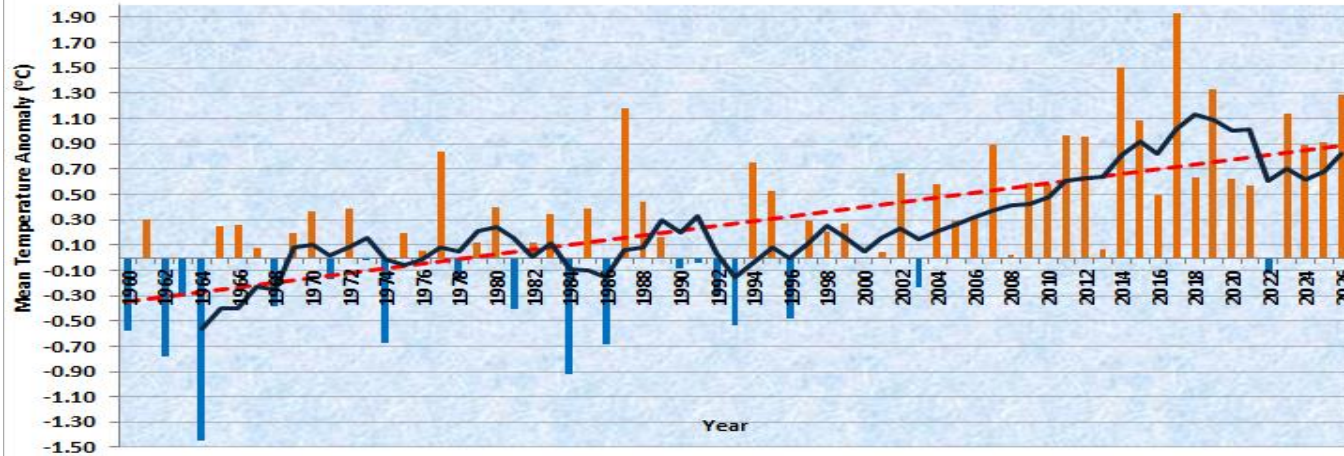
The highest number of cold nights was 15 at Domaine Les Pailles and Belle Mare.

Cold days



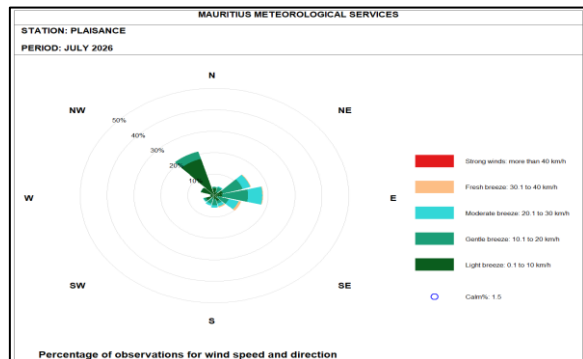
July Mean Temperature Anomaly- Base period 1961-1990



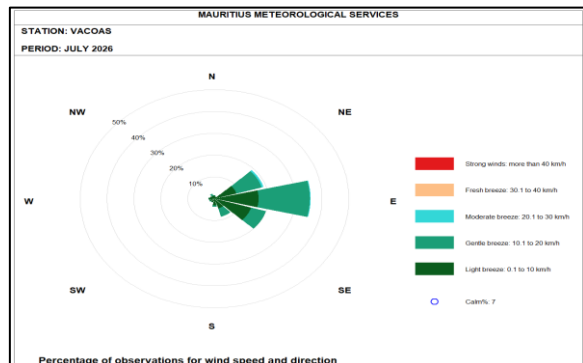
The mean temperature over the island was 0.82 °C warmer than the LTM of 1991-2020.

The mean maximum temperature was 1.6 °C warmer than long-term mean and the mean minimum temperature was close to the long-term mean.

Vacoas

Wind frequencies show winds mainly from the Eastern and South-eastern sectors both at Plaisance (top) and at Vacoas (bottom). Light to moderate winds prevailed most of the time over the island but on a few occasions light north-westerly winds were recorded at Plaisance.

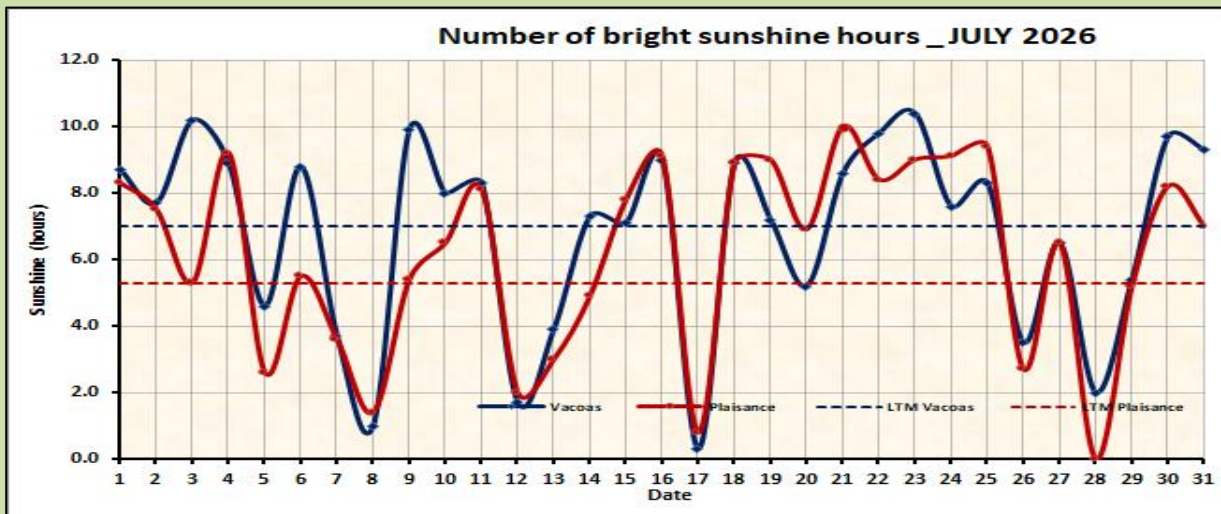
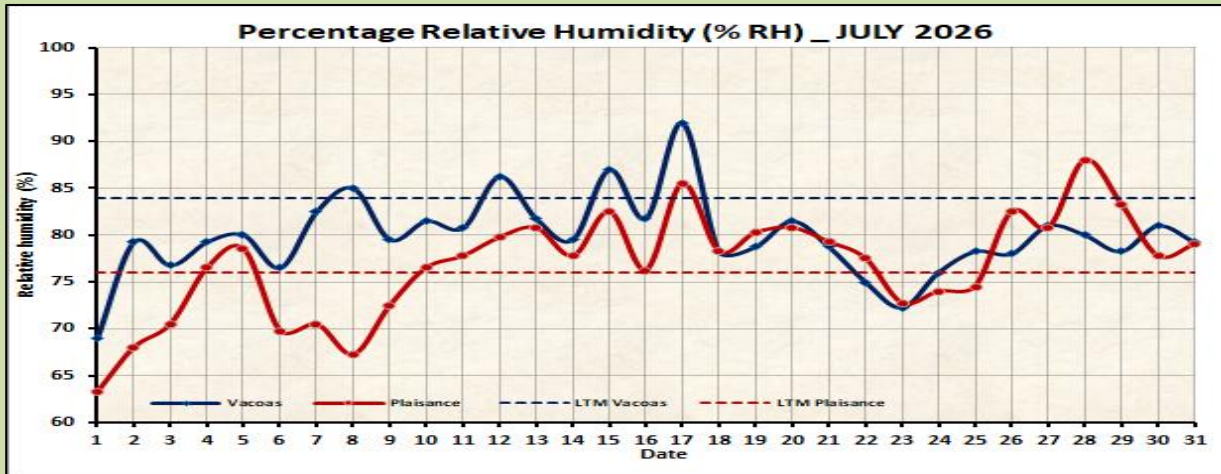

Sunshine and Humidity

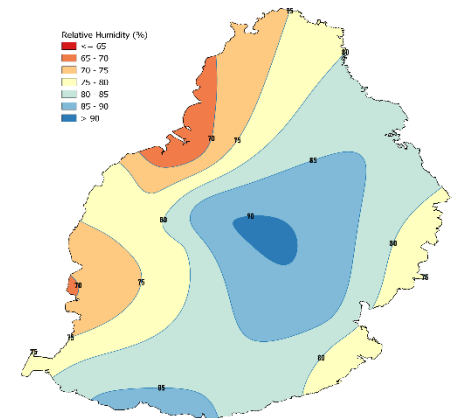
The mean relative humidity for the month was 92% at Vacoas and 88% at Plaisance. The daily humidity ranged from 69% to 92% at Vacoas and from 63% to 88% at Plaisance.

The average number of daily bright sunshine hours was 6.7 for Vacoas and 6.1 for Plaisance (anomaly of -0.3 at Vacoas and +0.8 at Plaisance). The total number of bright sunshine hours for the month was 211.5 at Vacoas and 191.3 at Plaisance.



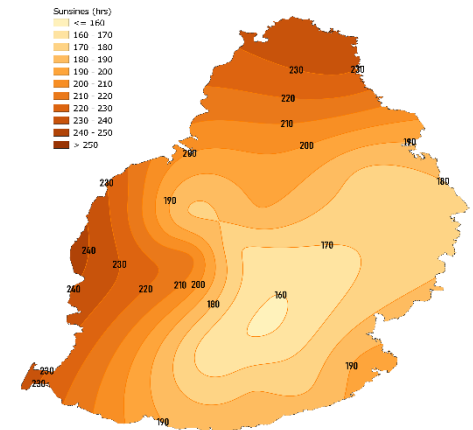
Monthly mean humidity July 2026

TOTAL MONTHLY SUNSHINE HOURS FOR JULY 2026

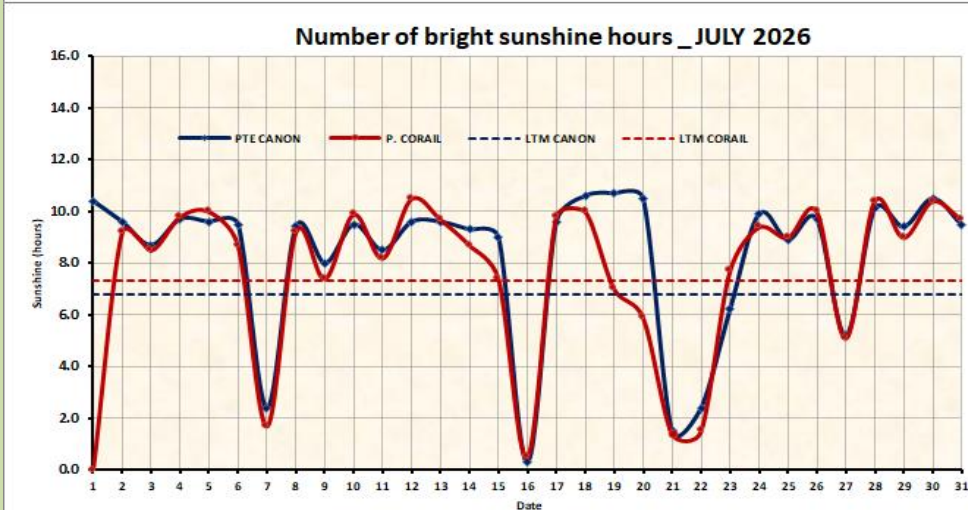
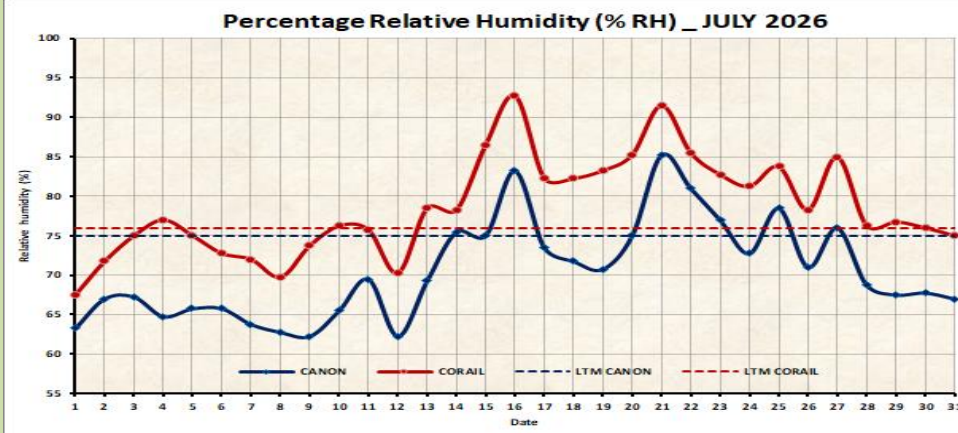

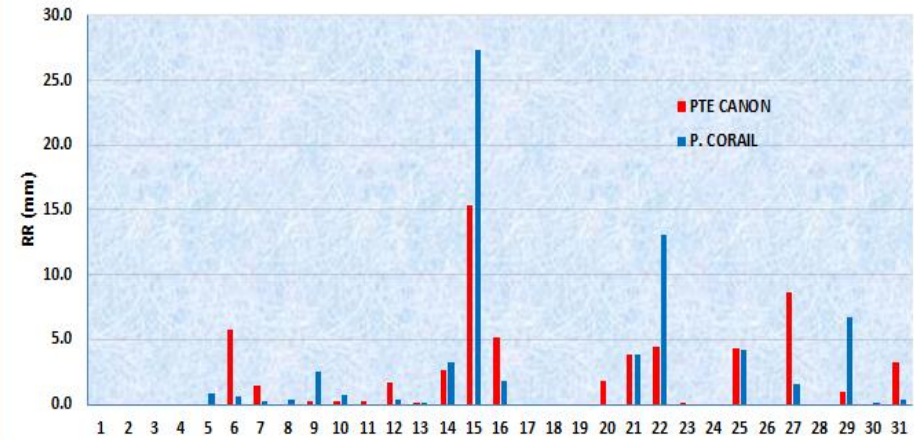
Sunshine and Humidity

The mean relative humidity for the month was 71% at Pointe Canon and 96% at Plaine Corail. The daily humidity ranged from 62% to 86% at Pointe Canon and from 66% to 93% at Plaine Corail.

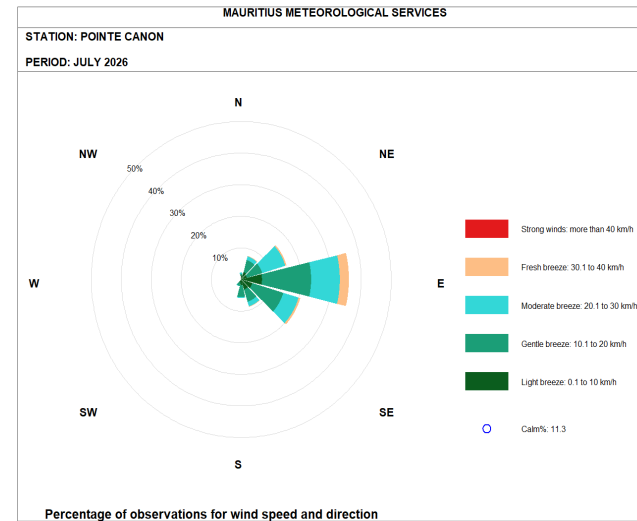
The average number of daily bright sunshine hours was 8.3 for Pointe Canon and 7.9 for Plaine Corail (anomaly of +1.5 at Pointe Canon and +0.6 at Plaine Corail). The total number of bright sunshine hours for the month was 257.8 at Pointe Canon and 235.7 at Plaine Corail.



RODRIGUES-RAINFALL JULY 2026

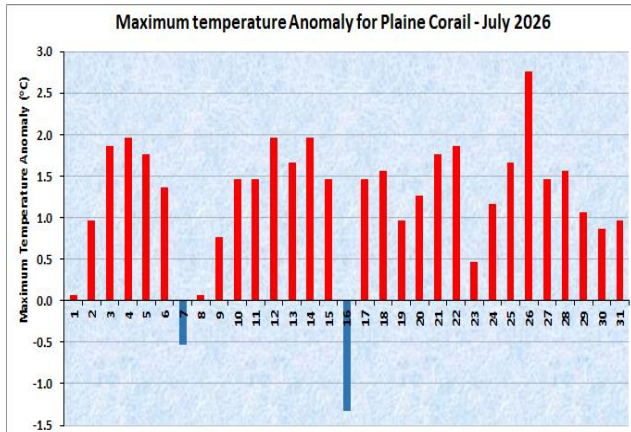
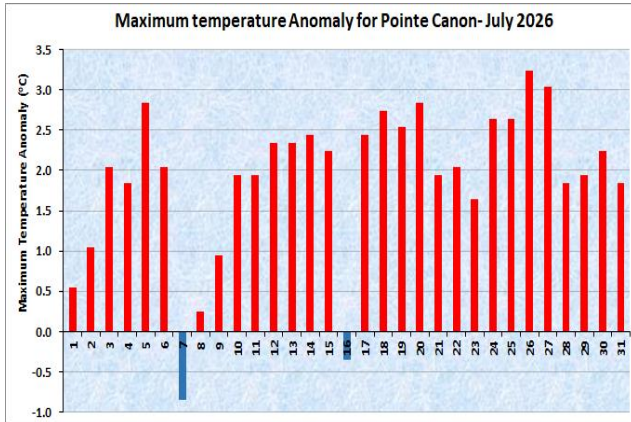


Rodrigues received below normal rainfall. Pointe Canon recorded 60.1 mm of rainfall (70% of the long-term mean) and Plaine Corail recorded 68.0 mm of rainfall (105% of the long-term mean).



Winds were mainly from the Eastern and South Eastern sectors at Pointe Canon during July 2026. Light to Moderate winds prevailed most of the time but on a few occasions Fresh trades were recorded at Pointe Canon.

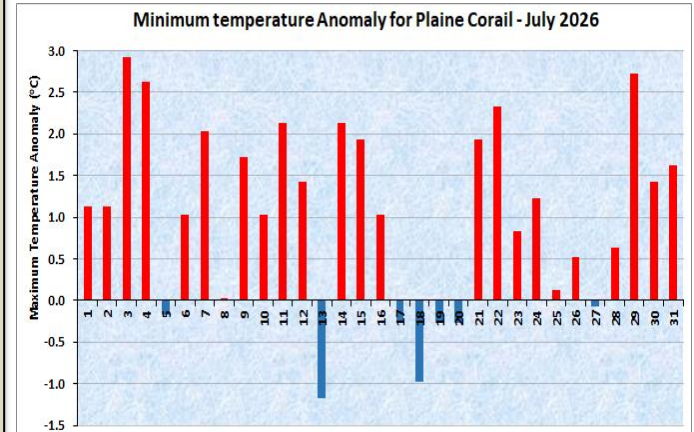
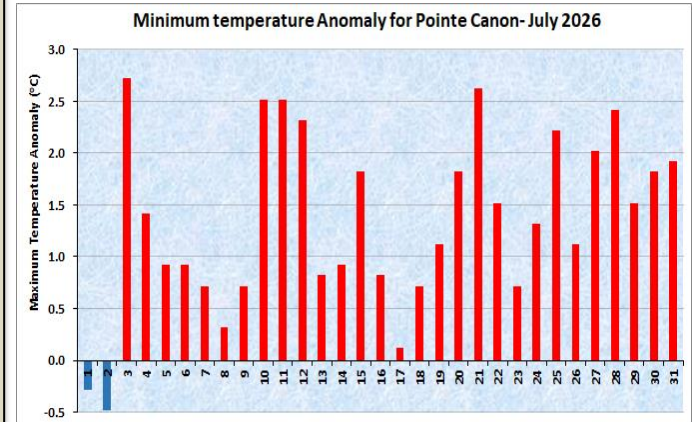
Minimum temperature was on average 1.3 °C and 1.0 °C warmer than the normal for Pointe Canon and Plaine Corail respectively.

Maximum temperature was 1.9 °C and 1.2 °C warmer than the normal for Pointe Canon and Plaine Corail respectively.

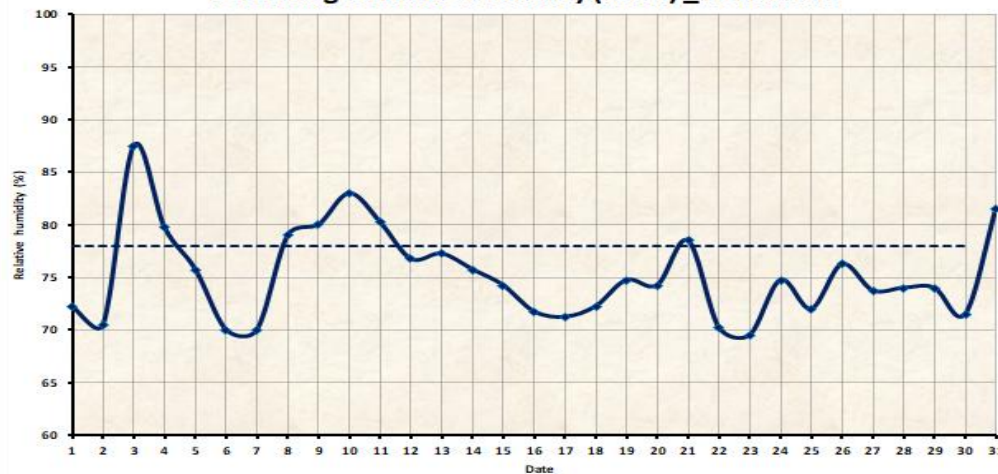

Sunshine and Humidity

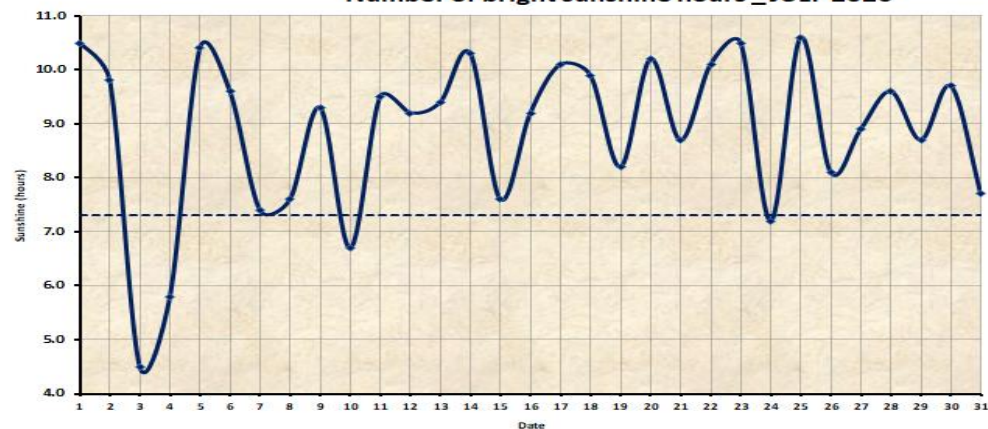
The mean relative humidity for the month at Agalega was 75 %. The daily humidity ranged from 70 % to 88 %.

The average number of daily bright sunshine hours was 8.9 at Agalega (positive anomaly of 1.6). The total number of bright sunshine hours for the month at Agalega was 275.0.

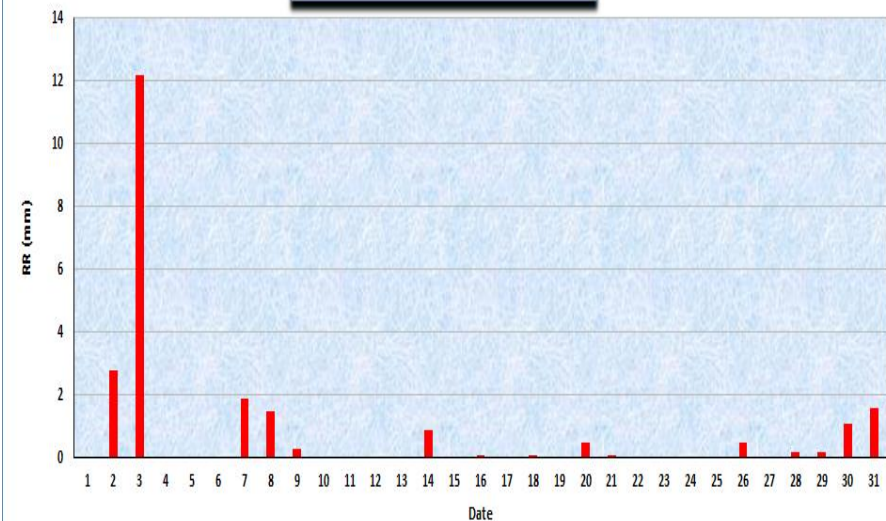
Percentage Relative Humidity (% RH) _ JULY 2026



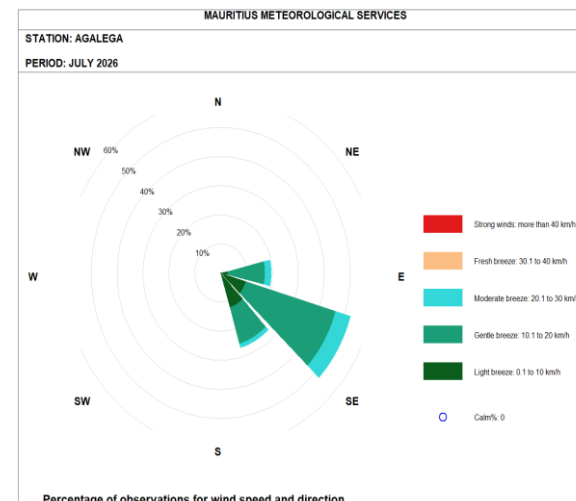
Number of bright sunshine hours _ JULY 2026



RAINFALL FOR THE MONTH OF JULY 2026

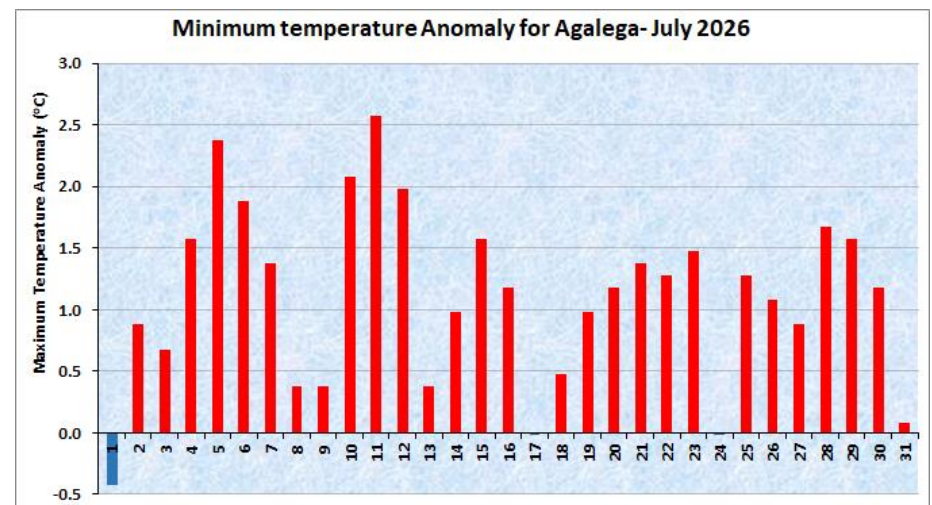
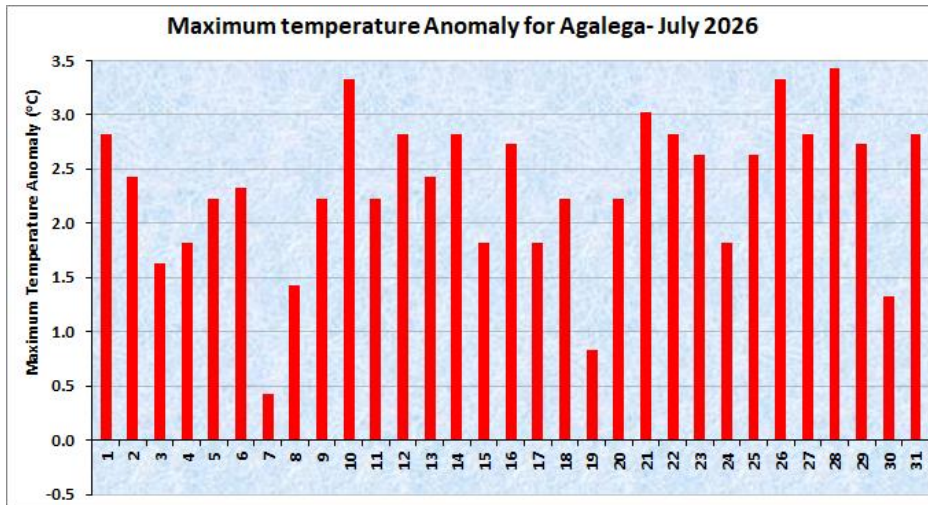


It was very dry at Agalega with about 24 mm and representing 23 % of the long-term mean. The highest 24-hour rainfall for the month was 12.2 mm, recorded on 03 July.



Winds were light to moderate at Agalega blowing from the south-eastern sectors during July 2026.

Maximum & Minimum Temperature – July 2026



The mean maximum temperature and the mean minimum temperature was warmer than the normal by 2.3 °C and 1.1 °C respectively. The highest maximum temperature at Agalega were 32.2 °C (28 July) and lowest maximum temperature recorded was 29.2 °C (07 July). The highest minimum temperature and lowest minimum temperature recorded at Agalega were 25.6 °C (11 July) and 22.6 °C (01 July) respectively.
