

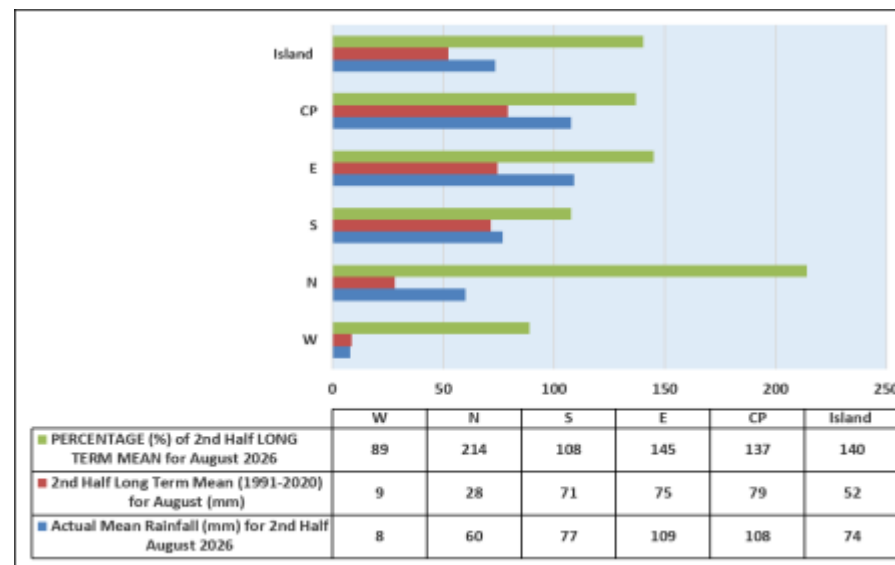
Mauritius Meteorological Services

Mean Rainfall for 16-31 August 2026 updated on 2 September 2026

Mauritius

Well above normal rainfall was recorded over Mauritius during the second fortnight of August 2026. Rainfall recorded amounted to 74 mm and representing 140 % of the long-term mean.

The East recorded the highest rainfall amounting to 109 mm, whereas the North had the highest percentage of 214 % of the long-term mean for the region.
